703. SANITARY MANAGEMENT

1. Purpose

The Joint Operating Committee recognizes that safeguarding the health and physical well-being of school students and staff depends upon the cleanliness and proper sanitary conditions of the Career Center and grounds.

2. Authority
SC 701

The Joint Operating Committee directs that a program of sanitary management shall be maintained in the Career Center and explained periodically to all staff members.

The Joint Operating Committee directs that standards be maintained to meet requirements set forth by the Pennsylvania Department of Health, Department of Labor & Industry and any local agency which has jurisdiction.

3. Delegation of
Responsibility

The Executive Director or designee shall develop and supervise a program for cleanliness and sanitary management of the Career Center, school grounds and Career Center equipment pursuant to statute, State Board regulations and requirements of the local and State Boards of Health and the Department of Labor & Industry.

Cleanliness of the Career Center shall be the responsibility of the Building and Grounds Supervisor.

Teachers shall be responsible for the general condition of their classroom or lab area.
