## 713 VANDALISM AND THEFT

1. Purpose

Incidents of willful or malicious abuse, destruction, defacement, and/or theft of property of the A. W. Beattie Career Center are contrary to the interests of the jointure and injurious to the rights and welfare of the community.

2. Authority

The A. W. Beattie Career Center shall seek all legal redress against persons found to have committed such acts under the laws of the State of Pennsylvania. Students guilty of vandalism will be subject to suspension and other disciplinary action.

3. Delegation of  
Responsibility

It is the instructor's responsibility, as well as the administration's, to see that students do not abuse, break or steal consumable items, tools or equipment. Under no circumstances is any equipment to be released to anyone unless authorized by the administration; with the properly completed required form.

Employees are to register all personal property and equipment, valued in excess of \$50, which is brought on school premises, by filing a list of such property or equipment with the school office. Any employee who fails to register any personal property or equipment valued in excess of fifty dollars (\$50.00) shall not be eligible for reimbursement in case of loss.
