910 COMMUNITY RELATIONS	
1. Purpose	The Joint Operating Committee feels that it is imperative that communication be maintained in both directions between the Career Center and local institutions, organizations and groups, such as industry, business, labor, charity and others which comprise the structure of the community.
2. Authority	The Joint Operating Committee has authority over the students in its care, but shares that authority to a limited extent through the cooperative programs that take students into the community during part of their educational career. To make those experiences meaningful, the Joint Operating Committee feels cooperation with the community is essential.
3. Delegation of Responsibility	<p>In reviewing cooperative programs, the administration shall keep in mind that the schools shall:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Maintain an impartiality among all constituents who promote worthy causes. 2. Not be used to promote private or commercial interests. 3. Not be used for direct sales promotion of goods or services. 4. Not assign students to outside tasks which do not primarily benefit the students.
