

### **AUTO BODY** BUDDIES

Campers will learn the basic concepts of auto body using hand tools, primary/ secondary colors, measuring, fabricating, safety, detail/pin striping, and wax station. Campers will be building a car model and metal license plate.

### AUTOMOTIVE MUSCLE MASTERS

The focus of this camp is home service fundamentals and safe working conditions. The items stressed include: fluid examinations, checking tire pressure, changing oil, filters, wiper blades and tires. Campers will work on actual vehicles, use common hand tools and experience a professional shop environment.

### BABYSITTING **BOOT CAMP**

A four day camp designed for 11-14 year olds interested in becoming a babysitter. Infant, child and adult CPR as well as First Aid basics will be taught. Campers will help plan and discuss child-appropriate, fun and engaging activities designed to work all three areas of a child's development.

BACK TO THE Come lead to cook with us like grandma is in the kitchen. We will focus on traditional technique and prepare students to cook "old school".

### **BEAUTY 101**

The focus of this camp is to teach the basic concepts of hair care, skin care, nail care and proper make-up application. Students will perform applications on themselves or a mannequin (provided for use).

### CAMP DESIGN

Learn the basics of graphic design in this new camp! Students will learn to create designs on the computer using Adobe Photoshop and Adobe Illustrator. Digital Photography, cartooning and production will also be discussed.

### CONSTRUCTION WORKERS, INC.

Campers will utilize the same building techniques as used in the residential framing industry to build a 1/8 scale ranch style house. They will also have the opportunity to wire household electrical switches and outlets, and lay brick and block. Shop safety, hand/power tool usage and blueprint reading are also part of our four day experience. The students will take their model house and a starter tool set home with them to remember their great experience for years to come.

### HVAC FURNACE FIXERS

Students will enjoy hands on learning while completing various projects relating to the HVAC (Heating, Ventilation and Air-Conditioning) field. Projects will include soldering a copper tubing project, installing an electrical circuit, constructing a metal box from sheet metal and using our virtual welder. Campers will also learn tool, shop and electrical safety before working with numerous pieces of equipment.

## KING ARTHUR FLOUR POWER

Campers will explore the fun and science behind making bread, pretzels, and other baked goods. Items will be created in bulk, as they would be in a bakery. Because of the volume of items baked, students will be able to not only enjoy their creations themselves, but also donate a portion of the baked goods to community members in need.

### LIFESAVERS

Explore your interest in the ever expanding field of Public Safety. Learn about the training and skills needed to serve your community EMS, Fire, Police including CPR with AED, fingerprinting, and fire engine operations.

### ROBO CAMP

Future roboticists and engineers can gain experience and have fun exploring careers in robotics by learning about the concepts of teamwork, planning, brainstorming, prototyping, programming, building plus testing robots to function and compete with other robots.

### TAE KWON DO

The students will experience an introduction to the Martial Arts incorporating the mind, body and spirit. Training will include self-discipline, physical exercise, and meditation. The students will receive instruction on self-defense techniques, forms, and stances using their hands and feet. The program will include the tenants of Courtesy, Integrity, Perseverance, Control and Indomitable Spirit.
