	<p>229. STUDENT FUNDRAISING</p>
1. Purpose	<p>The Joint Operating Committee acknowledges that solicitation of funds from students must be limited because compulsory attendance laws make the student a captive donor and such solicitation may disrupt the educational program of the school.</p>
2. Definition	<p>For purposes of this policy, <b>student fundraising</b> shall include solicitation and collection of money by students for any purpose and shall include collection of money in exchange for tickets, papers, advertising or any other goods or services.</p>
3. Authority	<p>The Joint Operating Committee prohibits in school, on school property, or at any school sponsored event the collection of money by a student for personal benefit.</p>
4. Delegation of Responsibility	<p>Collection of money by approved Career Center organizations may be permitted by the Executive Director or designee.</p> <p>All Career Center student organizations must submit the appropriate fundraising forms for approval.</p> <p>Collections by students on behalf of Career Center organizations outside the school may be permitted only by the Joint Operating Committee.</p> <p>The Executive Director shall develop administrative guidelines to implement this policy which shall limit the kind and amount of advertising for solicitation.</p> <p>The Administration shall distribute this policy and the rules which implement it to each student organization granted permission to solicit funds.</p>
Pol. 618	<p>Funds solicited shall be controlled by Student Body Finances, Joint Operating policy 618. All funds must be deposited into the Student Activities accounts of the Career Center.</p>
