239. MEMORIAL FUNDS AND SCHOLARSHIPS	
1. Purpose	<p>The purpose of the memorial fund/scholarship must be stated clearly. Purposes may include, but are not limited to, the following:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Pursuit of continuing education in the student's field of study. 2. Purchase of tools or materials to aid in the furthering of the student's career.
2. Authority	<p>The Joint Operating Committee authorizes the establishment of the memorial fund.</p>
3. Guidelines	<p>Any memorial funds or scholarships given to the A. W. Beattie Career Center shall become the property of the school; such donations will be irrevocable and once made are subject to the guidelines under which the memorial fund or scholarship was established.</p> <p>With the approval of the Joint Operating Committee, a committee to include the Executive Director, an administrator, and other appropriate persons will be established to make decisions regarding the criteria by which the recipient of said funds will be chosen. This committee shall choose the recipient based on the set criteria.</p> <p>The establishment of the account and investment of any monies in the account will be left to the discretion of the Business Manager.</p> <p>The committee shall determine the manner by which the funds will be disbursed in individual cases; money may be given directly to the recipient or it may be given to the educational institution in the event that the student is continuing his/her education.</p> <p>In the event that the memorial fund or scholarship fund is no longer able to serve its designated purpose, it shall be terminated, and any money remaining in the account will be transferred to another account which serves the same purpose. Proper acknowledgment of the source of the funds should be made in such situations by some reasonable means.</p>
