### Honors Graduate Criteria

**Graduation Awards Honors Graduate Award:** To graduate with the distinction of Honors Graduate, students must graduate with a cumulative GPA of at least 3.5 (calculated using four non-rounded decimal places) and a minimum of 16 honors courses. During the senior year, honors graduates must be enrolled in and complete a senior honors course in each of the four core areas (English, math, science, and social studies).

**Valedictorian and Salutatorian Awards** are determined by the overall GPA (calculated using four non-rounded decimal places) of the honors graduates. In order to be eligible for these highest awards, students must have completed 18 honors courses and have taken the most rigorous curriculum offered at Catholic High School during their years as a student. In an academic advising meeting at the time of scheduling, candidates for these designations will be given notice of which courses must be taken in the subsequent year to be eligible for this honor. Those courses must include the most rigorous courses (H/DE/AP) offered in each department. This determination is made by the Academic Council in conjunction with the Administration. English I, II, III, and IV; World Geography, Civics, US History, and World History; Algebra I, Geometry, Algebra II, and Pre-Calculus, Physical Science, Biology I, Chemistry, AP Chemistry, AP Calculus, and an eighteenth honors course approved by Administration. In order to qualify for Valedictorian or Salutatorian, a student must be in full attendance at CHS for their sophomore, junior, and senior years.
