IS NOT REQUIRED TO EITHER TAKE OR TEACH OUR CLASSES. THE FALL AND SPRING SESSIONS SERVE CHILDREN AND ADULTS OF ALL AGES. THE SUMMER SESSION IS TYPICALLY HELD DURING THE MONTH OF JUNE AND SERVES SCHOOL AGE YOUTHS THROUGH WEEKLY DAYTIME PROGRAMS AT FRIENDSWOOD JUNIOR HIGH. ALL OF OUR INSTRUCTORS ARE BACKGROUND CHECKED AND CLEARED THROUGH HR.
