

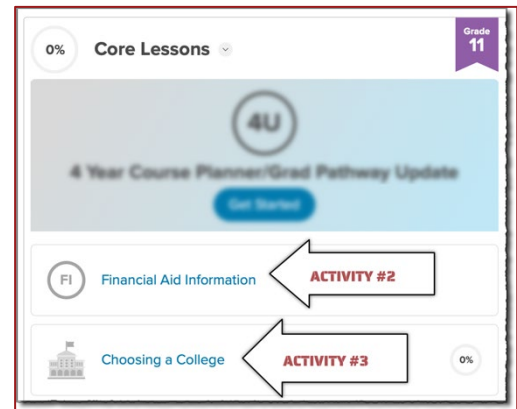

- Activity 3. Complete the **Choosing a College** Core Lesson in Xello

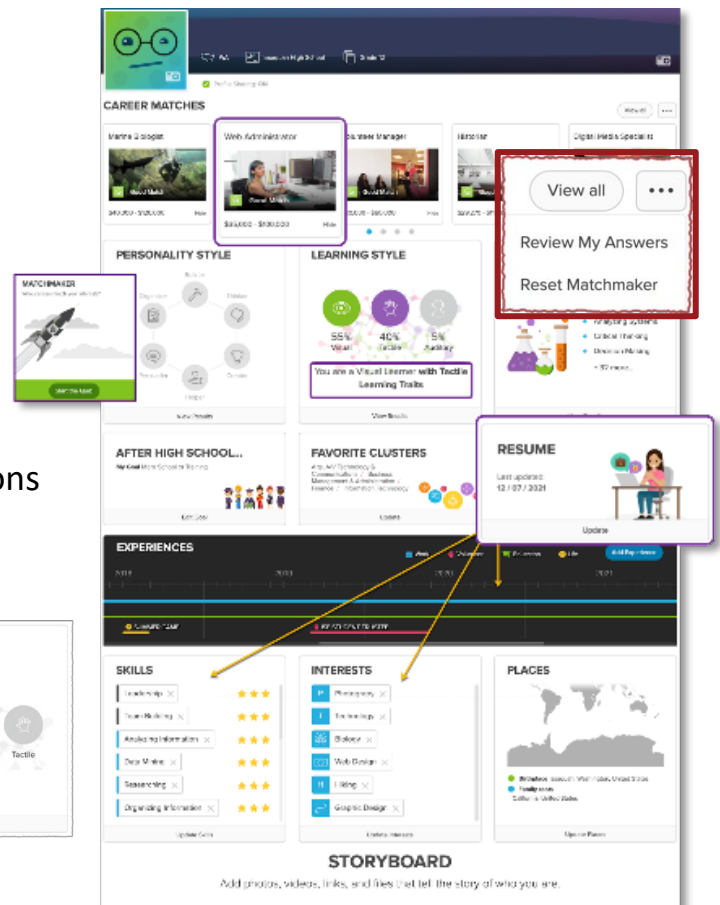

Activity #1: Log in to Xello

You can log in to Xello from your [ClassLink account](#). If you have any trouble logging into Xello, contact Mr. Ward (tward@lwsd.org).

- Step 1. Click [here](#) to go to **ClassLink**.
- Step 2. Click on the **Xello icon**.
- Step 3. Click on **About Me** (located at the top)
- Step 4. Review and update the **About Me** section (*optional*). If you have not done the **Matchmaker** or **Learning Style** assessments, click on **Start the Quiz**, review your answers, or reset **Matchmaker**. Visit the different sections and update accordingly to create a **portfolio that is about you!**



Activity #2: Financial Aid Information

This lesson will help you with everything you need to know about getting money for a four-year, community college, or technical school, and provides links and resources on FAFSA, WASFA, College Bound Scholarship, and WA College Grant.

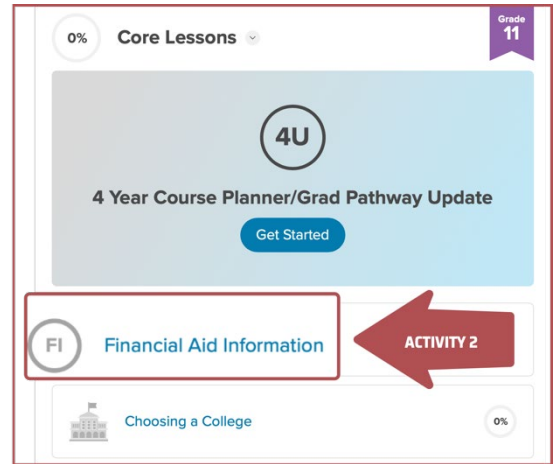
Step 1. From your **Dashboard**, click on **Financial Aid Information** link located under the **Core Lessons**.

Step 2. Review the information and resources.

Step 3. Answer the questions in the text box provided.

Step 4. Click **Turn In** when complete.

When you have fully completed the task, the progress bar at the top of the page will show 100%. Then click on the **Done** button to return to the main page. On this page, you'll now see a **green checkmark** next to the **Financial Aid Information** core lesson showing you successfully completed this activity.



Activity #3: Choosing a College

The **Choosing a College** CORE lesson in Xello will help you explore how a post-secondary education pathway may fit in your future, **if you have not saved at least 3 schools of interest, you must complete the prerequisite lesson first.**

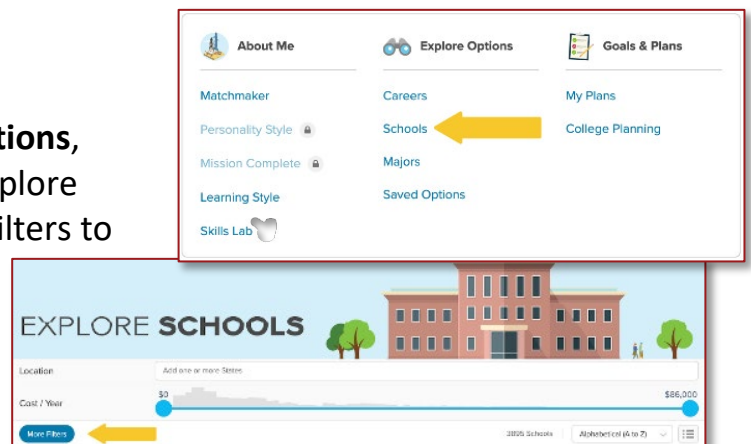
Part 1 of Activity 3: **Prerequisite** (if needed): **Save at least 3 Schools of Interest.**

There are different options to explore schools in Xello whether it be a 2-or 4-year college, technical, or trade program.

Option 1. **Filter by Criteria**

From your **Dashboard**, under **Explore Options**, click on **Schools**. On this page, you can explore schools by browsing the list, and setting filters to narrow the list to schools of interest.

Click on the blue **More Filters** button and then select filters to narrow your search.

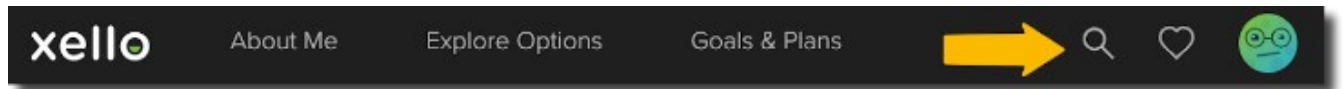


Tip: Do not filter by cost/year. Many schools make up the difference in cost with scholarships.

Activity #3: Choosing a College CONTINUED

Option 2. **Search** (Magnifying Glass)

You can also search for a specific school of interest. Click on the **magnifying glass icon** in the upper right, and then enter a search term and click enter to see the results.



Don't forget to save schools of interest! When you find a school of interest. Click the **heart icon** to save it to your Xello account.



Part 2 of Activity 3: **Complete Core Lesson: Choosing a College**

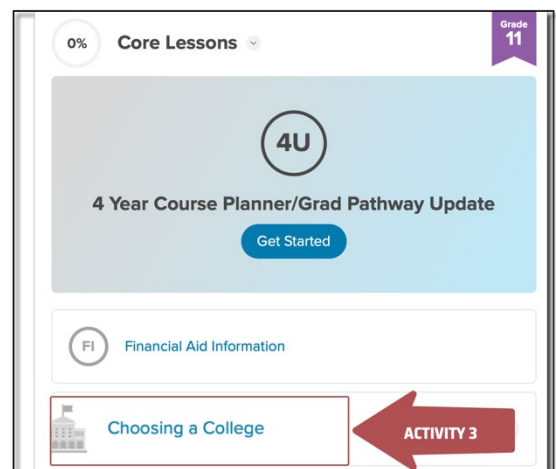
In this lesson, you will explore how a college pathway may fit into your future by considering how you feel and what options are important to you.
