FARIBAUT TEACHING FELLOWS PROGRAM

This grant program is designed to increase the number of **Black, Indigenous, or People of Color (BIPOC)** who become teachers.

To qualify, you must meet one of the following requirements:

- Be a current Faribault Public Schools employee
- Have graduated from Faribault Public Schools
- Be a parent of a current Faribault Public Schools student or graduate
- Live within the Faribault Public School district boundaries

Three application deadlines per year:

- * March 1
- * May 1
- * November 1

YOU'LL RECEIVE:

- Tuition assistance up to **\$3,000** per year
- Stipend to assist with other living or college costs up to **\$2,000 per year**
- One-on-one **advising support** throughout the program
- Connection with a **mentor teacher**
