Are you up to the challenge?</p>	<p><b>SOCIAL STUDIES</b></p> <p>On a sheet of paper answer the following question, in a paragraph. Most ancient civilizations developed along a river. Explain why they would need to be next to a river, and give a specific example from one of the four river valley civilizations we have studied in class.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>OR</b></p> <p>Watch CNN10, a news channel, or read a news article in the newspaper or a magazine. Provide a summary about the current events you learned about. Will any of the current events affect you or not? Explain. (Write at least two paragraphs).</p>
<p><b>MATH</b></p> <p>Amber has three pairs of pants and seven shirts she wears all the time. How many different combinations can she make with these outfits?</p> <p>Chris has 4 dogs for sale at \$65 a piece, 3 chickens for \$15 a piece, and 7 frogs for \$3.25 a piece. If he sells all his pets how much money will he have?</p> <p>The distance around the bases is 4x90 feet. How many runs does a baseball team need to score before the scoring base runners have covered a mile? (1 mile = 5,280 feet)</p>	<p><b>SCIENCE</b></p> <p>You will be modeling patterns of motion of the sun and Earth. If a basketball is used to represent the sun, and a tennis ball is used to represent Earth. In order to accurately model the cause of day and night on Earth, what action with the given models would you need to perform? Draw your answer.</p>	<p><b>RELATED ARTS</b></p> <p>Listen to one of your favorite songs and identify what instruments are playing in it. Identify what genre the song is and what musical characteristics contribute to making the song a part of the genre.</p> <p>Your answer must be in paragraph form.</p>
