## **Primary - essential supplies**

Students are requested to bring the following supplies with them on their first day of school (or to replace them, as needed, during the school year).

## YEARS 1, 2 & 3

- Inexpensive headphones (not blue tooth)
- A child's backpack of suitable size for their age and height

## YEAR 4

- Inexpensive headphones (not blue tooth)
- A pencil case that includes:
  - A pack of HB pencils
  - Erasers/rubbers
  - Coloured pencils
  - Glue stick
  - Pencil sharpener with lid
  - Scissors
  - 30 centimetre ruler

## **YEARS 5 & 6**

- Inexpensive headphones (not blue tooth)
- A pencil case that includes:
  - A package of HB pencils
  - Erasers/rubbers
  - Coloured pencils
  - Pencil sharpener with lid
  - Black fine point writing pen
  - Highlighters
  - Scissors
  - 15 centimetre ruler
  - Glue stick
  - Calculator (basic type, solar if possible)
  - Protractor



# Primary - dressing for all weather

It can be tricky knowing what your child might need for all the different types of weather in Norway. This overview gives you an idea of what they should wear by temperature range. If it is raining, your child will need rain gear and boots. They can wear this over their regular clothes. If it is cold and wet, they should wear warm layers under their rain gear.

## 12+ degree celsius

If it is raining, your child will need rain gear and rain boots. They can wear this over their regular clothes.



#### 8-12 degrees celsius

Regular clothes and good rain gear as above. A warm fleece under the rain gear is a good idea. Rain gloves with a pair of thin wool gloves to wear underneath.







#### 5-8 degrees celsius

Regular clothes and good rain gear as above. A warm fleece under the rain gear is a good idea. Rain gloves with a pair of thin wool gloves to wear underneath.





# Primary - dressing for all weather

## 0-4 degrees celsius (with rain)

Wool inner layer and fleece under rain gear. Wool socks are a must to help keep feet warm, especially if using summer rain boots. Thin wool gloves under rain gloves. A thin hat is also good to use during this time.



## O degrees celsius (or below)

Your child will need a wool inner layer and fleece along with their snowsuit and rain gear. We put the rain gear over to help the snow suit stay dry. A good pair of wool lined boots are a must at this temperature. Once again, rain gloves and wool gloves underneath. Most winter gloves are not made to stay dry in the rain. A cosy hat is nice to keep the head and ears warm.
