



2023-2024 School Year Elementary & Middle School Program Tuition Rates

At MAC, new tuition rates for the Elementary and Middle School programs go into effect on the first day of school, August 22, 2023. We strive to be open and honest with families at all times, and we will inform families via email and our website when changes are made to our tuition and fees. These changes are typically voted on by our Board of Trustees in January for the next school year.

Fees and Other Information

Application Fee: A non-refundable application fee of \$100 per child is due at the time the application is submitted.

Enrollment Deposit: A deposit of \$1,000 per child will be required to secure your child's spot in the Elementary or Middle School program. This deposit is credited back to your account each month during the school year. Should you choose not to enroll your child, this deposit is forfeited.

Enrollment Fee: When a spot is offered and your family decides to accept a space at MAC, we require a \$750 non-refundable enrollment fee with acceptance (\$500 is a one-time family enrollment fee, and there is a \$250 placement fee per child enrolling at MAC).

Building Fee: MAC is a large school and our building requires regular maintenance. A \$550.00 Building Reserve Fund fee is due upon enrollment of school and at the start of each school year for each family enrolled at MAC to ensure that our building remains a safe place for your children to learn and grow. This fee is prorated for students enrolling mid-year.

Middle School Experience Fee: There is a \$1,000 Annual Experience Fee for Middle School only, this is used to support place-based student educational activities during the academic year which may include transportation, registration, admission, and instructional materials.

Admissions Overview

Prior to a family being offered a placement at MAC, we require a family interview with the child's parent(s) or guardian(s). This interview allows the family to have a more personal conversation with our Admissions Team.

Children will be invited to our Elementary or Middle School program to spend half or a whole day to work and be assessed by our Admissions Team.
