### Planning Your Display



You have been reading, researching, measuring, experimenting and learning for a few weeks now. You probably have so many things you've discovered and learned. So, what do you do with all the information you've collected? That depends on what your project is about. You could display your project in many ways.

1. **Display board** - The typical way to display projects to use a display board. These boards are free standing, 3 section boards that give you plenty of space to display the information.

*Please do NOT use the display boards that have a "header" across the top. We have limited space & that kind takes up a lot of space! 😊*

**Lay your display items on your board before gluing!**

**Then you can move them around if you don't like the placement.**

**Questions to ask yourself BEFORE gluing:**

- Do I have a title?
- Did I write my name under the title?
- Is my display neat and easy to read?
- Did I clearly explain what I learned?
- Did I check my spelling?
- Did I do my best work?



2. **BE CREATIVE!** Maybe you don't want to be typical. Let your imagination run wild...What is a different way to display the information you have collected during your learning experience? Did you learn to ride a bike? We could find a spot for a bike. Did you make some clothing? Maybe you can find a display model to use. There are so many ways to display your project...use YOUR imagination!

**REMEMBER:** You are **not** allowed to have live animals, food, candy, perfumes, or chemicals of any kind in your display. Also, if an item is valuable or irreplaceable, please do **not** include it in your display.
