Q: (Suany) - What are the structural considerations for the DEI Coordinator?

A: (Dr. Champ) - A consultant may be a possible consideration. But we then have to consider what the goals would be. Does BOCES have resources to assist building to do this work? Do we hire a P/T position, do we distribute the work to existing staff? Work is still moving forward.

(Suany) - Still worried about the bias if done internally, meaning wouldn't an outside hire provide a better perspective for change to occur?

Q: (Kim Espinosa) - What is the timeline and goal?

A: (Dr. Champ) - we would like to make a move ASAP. It is planned to be discussed at the next BoE meeting since there may be a change in direction. Will pick a direction in the next few weeks.

Q: (Jen Silvester) - Are you open to recommendations for candidates?

A: (Dr. C) - YES

Q: (Kim Melloy) - Do we have an update on the Playground install at Hutchinson?

A: (Dr. C) - We are looking at a redesign and repurchase. We needed to be able to drill down 3ft. and can only get down 2 ft. before hitting rock. We will need to utilize Juliannes for the remainder of the school year.

Q: (Kim) - Can the stairs from Lincoln Ave. be opened yet or is it contingent on the playground being finished? Need to alleviate foot traffic and cars through the Fifth St. area.

A: (Dr. C) - Structural issues on the stairs themselves must be remediated first. It is not dependent on the playground completion. Will check on a timeline.

Q: (David Sparano) - Do we have an update on the playground at Siwanoy?

A: (Dr. C) - We have to source parts and possibly redesign. There is a lack of replacements for the existing equipment. Master plan for playgrounds being developed. There is a consultant looking at remodeling at other 3 elementaries as well.

(Alex Wolff) - RFP has already been advertised.

Probably during next year, not culminating by next summer.

Q: (Stephanie Otero) - Is Julianne's included in that redesign?

A: (Allison) - Conversations and surveying done with JLP. One way or another Julianne's will happen.

Dr. Champ - Thank you to everyone for your patience on all of these topics. Please continue to advertise Re-Centering and Redirecting (to the appropriate people) at the building level. And encourage parents to work with the teachers and administrators.
