The cycle includes evaluation of current materials, selection of new curricula, creation of unit overviews, lesson plans, and assessments, refinement of materials selected, a three to four year period of implementation, and consistent measure of effectiveness before reevaluation.

**Step in Cycle Color Shading:**

1. Review for Renewal (Internal Audit)
2. Selection/Creation (Stakeholder Input)
3. Implementation/Refinement Period
4. Evaluation Period (Progress Monitor)
