CLOC (Citizen-Led Oversight Committee)

The CLOC is an independent group of appointed volunteers that has a mission to independently monitor all building projects, schedules, budgets and expenditures from the Beaufort County School District's November 2019 Bond Referendum, thereby ensuring proper use of Beaufort County taxpayer funds and superior facilities for Beaufort County students.

CLOC members bring a wide variety of professional experiences to their assigned tasks. Members include CPAs, urban planners, civil engineers, and project managers. The committee oversees the progress and spending for each of the Bond Referendum projects and then reports directly to the public and the Board of Education.

CLOC meetings are held once a month with the District's Operations staff, Financial Services staff and CBRE-Heery Program Manager staff. Materials for each monthly meeting are distributed prior to the meeting and posted to the CLOC webpage. Minutes of each CLOC meeting are posted once approved by the committee. The CLOC webpage also contains links to individual project reports that are updated monthly.

Quarterly reports from the CLOC are presented to the Beaufort County Board of Education. These quarterly reports are posted to the <u>CLOC webpage</u>.

Updated financial details are reviewed by the CLOC monthly. These monthly financial reports are available to the public on the CLOC webpage, such as the most recent <u>Referendum Projects 2019</u> Financial Summary.

As of October 31, 2022, the CLOC committee has overseen Bond Referendum expenditures that total \$174,173,410 and additional financial commitments that total \$148,516,642. The sum of these two figures is \$322,690,052 and equates to 85.9% of the total approved funds.
