SECURITY MONITORS

Mission and Purpose

-  To create a safer environment, for students, district personnel, visitors and property. Monitoring of campuses, facilities and parking areas to reduce the opportunity for theft, vandalism, and destructive activities, and limit unauthorized access to grounds and facilities utilizing an observe and report protocol.
-  Will spend most of their time at the high school campuses (occasional reassignments)
-  No longer using contracted security company
-  This initiative will grow over time to include mobile monitoring, longer hours of coverage, etc.



AED/CPR AND STOP THE BLEED

The entire Safety and Security Team is certified in CRP-AED and Stop the Bleed. Medical City of Denton and Texas DPS partnered with our nurses to deliver this training. Was a great day of training at BNHS.



FIRE EXTINGUISHER/METAL DETECTION

-  Know how to properly report component failure.

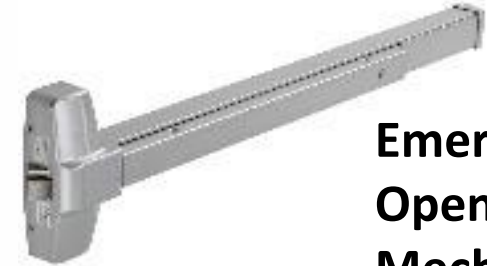
DOOR COMPONENTS

POSSIBLE MALFUNCTIONS

Mullions

-  Missing – Taken out
-  Need adjustment – Latch not catching on mullion
-  Loose and/or missing screws

Door Frames





-  Buildings settle causing rubbing with door
-  Paint can cause closing issues

Door Auto Closure




-  Physically broken – Often times the arms
-  Piston damage
-  Pressure adjustment

POSSIBLE MALFUNCTIONS

Auto Door Locks

-  Door latch sticks
-  Power failure to the door
-  Jam latch failure / damage
-  Vestibule air pressure

Emergency Open Mechanism

-  May find it “barred” down
-  Internal operation failure – stuck in open position
-  Latch sticks

HOW TO REPORT

SchoolDudeapps

- 🎓 **Know your campus “SchoolDude” representatives**
 - 🎓 Report your findings right away
 - 🎓 Take photo and email
 - 🎓 Be as descriptive as possible and include the door number
- 🎓 **May require a door monitor if door can’t be secured**

GOOD PRACTICES – DOOR SECURITY



LOOK

- 🎓 Does the door look secure?
- 🎓 Look for uneven doors?
- 🎓 Is the door propped?
- 🎓 Are there prop objects near the door?
 - 🎓 Rocks
 - 🎓 Rolled up floor mat
- 🎓 Does anything look out of place or not right?

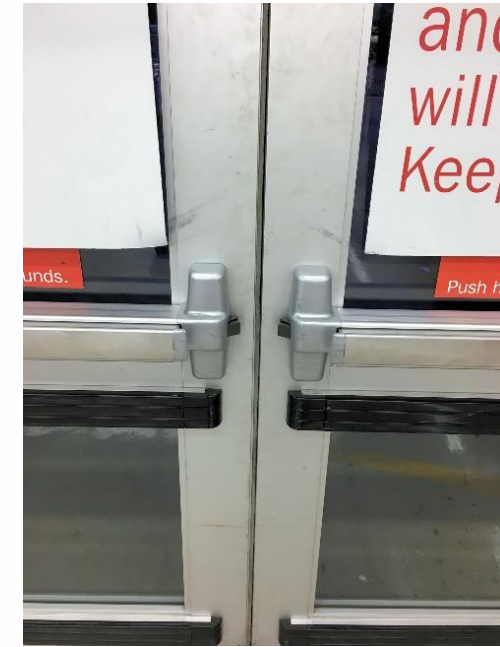
LOOK – EXAMPLE IMAGES



Emergency Open
Mechanism is pushed in.
This means the door is
probably unlocked.



Latch is stuck inside
housing. This means
door will not secure.



Mullion is missing.
Doors will not secure.

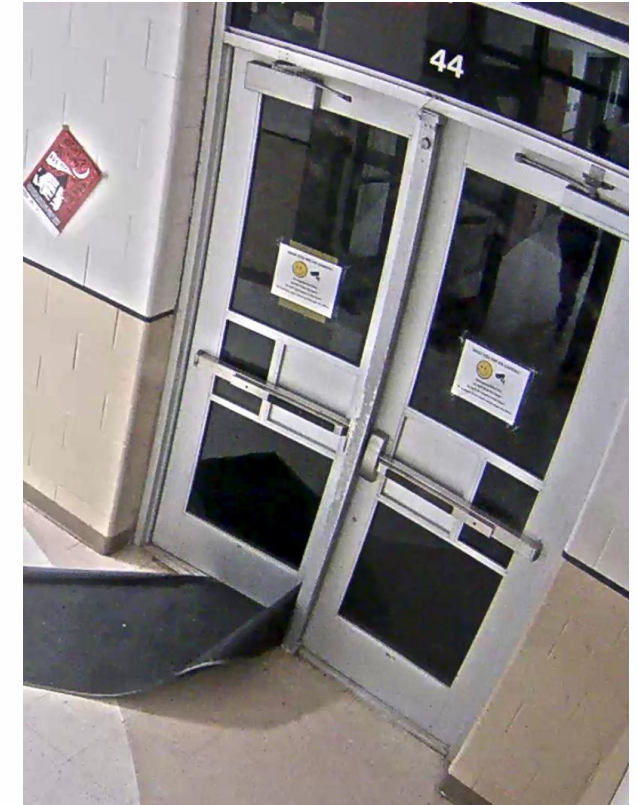
LOOK – EXAMPLE IMAGES

LISTEN & LATCH

- 🎓 **Does the door make abnormal sounds**
 - 🎓 Scraping
 - 🎓 Rubbing, etc.
- 🎓 **Did the door sound like it latched?**
- 🎓 **Check the door.**
