Safe Technology and Digital Citizenship: (Dr. Lori Hawthorne & Scott Waters)

School Safety - Scott Waters representing the school technology department. The different options of filtering:

IBOSS - flags key words in the system

Net Ref - takes pictures (new site)

Net Support - in the computer labs and can take over students computer live

Lynette attended to express a parent concern regarding filters and technology. Her experience is that she called Scott Waters and received positive help. The schools response is that concerns are always addressed by a case by case basis. Lynette would like for the school to let people know the school is willing to help. Concerns were addressed and mostly focused on filters and how to stop Spotify music that is explicit language or inappropriate links to podcasts.

What the administrative sees mostly on the the filters is you tube or gaming on the computer (wasting time). Assessments are always being made on the computers and the IT department is always able to capture student id.

During the school day they sometimes see searches with key words "How to die" on school devices. When that happens the student is immediately checked out of class and parents are notified.
