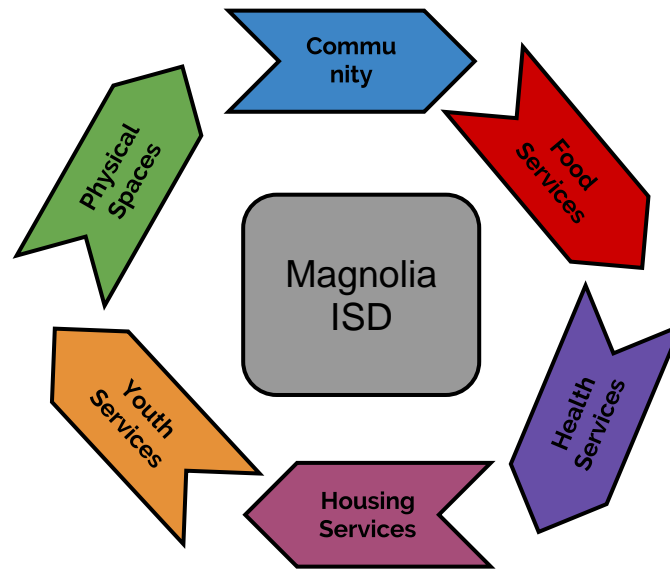


School Community Asset Mapping
