Summary for Meetings (virtual meetings 8-24-20; 2-8-2021)

With the waiver for the number of council meetings, the school hosted two meetings. All meetings were held virtually. Parents attended meetings via Zoom and signed in on the chat box.

In the first meeting (8-12-2020), officers were elected, and all members were trained on the GA School Council Guidebook. The school improvement plan - goals and strategies discussed and input was solicited from the members to revise and approve plan. New staff members, School Resource Deputy (duties and responsibilities), budget and school enrollment were presented. Parent engagement allocations and expenditures, compacts, and parent engagement policy were also presented, discussed, and revised. Due to COVID-19, all activities bringing groups together were put on hold.

In the second meeting (2-8-2021), school council discussions consisted of 40 Days of Legislation, proposed FY'22 school budget, school enrollment with FY'22 class size projection, FY'22 fund raisers, FY'22 school activities/events, GMAS, and STAR 360 testing dates. Discussed the upcoming school improvement plan for FY'22 and school improvement goals. Parent-Family Engagement District and schools 2021-2022 plans were presented for council input. Input from parents regarding 2021-2022 compacts 1% Parent-Family Engagement Allocation Expenditure was shared with the council. Due to members' terms ending as of May 2021, new members will be appointed with the suggestion of the committee in August 2021.
