

## General Requirements for the 2022 Grand List Elderly or 100% Disabled Homeowners Program

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Homeowners, 65 years and older, or Homeowners 100% disabled through Social Security (no age requirement) who meet specific guidelines, may be eligible for property tax relief. Below are the general requirements for the program. Please contact the Assessment Office at 860-561-7414 with any questions you may have.

— This is a State Program —

Age Requirement:	65 years of age as of December 31, 2022
Application Period:	February 1 - May 15, 2023
Maximum Income Allowed:	Single: \$40,300      Married: \$49,100
Information Needed:	Date of Birth and Social Security Numbers for Applicants; Proof of <b><u>ALL</u></b> income for 2022 (taxable and non-taxable)
Benefit:	Works on a sliding scale: Minimum of \$150 off taxes Maximum of \$1,250 off taxes

### Elderly or 100% Disabled Homeowner Program Checklist

The state requires proof of all income. Please submit the following when applying for the Elderly Homeowner Program:

- A copy of the 2022 1099 form from Social Security;
- A copy of an Income Tax Return for 2022;
- If no Income Tax Return was filed, submit copies of **ALL** 1099 forms;
- Copies of receipts for Rental Income, if applicable;
- W-2 forms, if applicable
