II. WHY BOARD ACTION IS NECESSARY  Pursuant to RCW 39.04, administrative procedures for Board Policy 9240 - Construction Phase, and Policy and Procedure 6225 - Approval of Contracts, require School Board approval for all contracts of \$250,000.00 or more.

#### III. BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The 2016 Capital Improvement Bond provides funds for safety and security upgrades at district school sites, including security video system replacement. Due to the size of the project and complexity of the work, the project was divided into phases. Phase 1 included 15 district school sites and was approved by the board in February 2022. Other phases, if needed, will be introduced to the board at a later date.

The scope of work for the Phase 2 project is to replace existing obsolete DIVAR, Netguard, and Ocularis video systems with a new cloud-based video management system platform by Verkada, with Internet Protocol (IP) cameras that are equipped with 30 days of internal storage and a 3-year license per camera for the following eleven (11) school sites:

Aviation, Cascade, Sylvester, Hilltop, Marvista, McMicken, Midway, Parkside, Shorewood, Olympic Interim, New Start.

The district also requested an alternate option that includes 60 days of internal storage and a 3-year license per camera. District staff reached out to five state vendors and requested proposals.

The district received multiple proposals for the installation of the new security camera system. XXXX has been determined to be the lowest, most responsive, and most responsible contractor. The XXXX alternate option proposal is in the amount of \$XXXXXXXX, including sales tax.—MicroK12 provides the district with a proposal for an option that includes 60 days of internal storage and a 3-year license per camera in the amount of \$1,646,305.8 including Washington sales tax.

Hargis Engineers and district staff have reviewed the proposal, and the cost of the work aligns with the scope. Staff recommends approving the XXXX-\$1,646,305.8 proposal for the alternate option that includes 60 days of internal storage and a 3-year license per camera. Pricing is through Washington School Information Processing Cooperative (WSIPC) #20-01. The request for quote tabulation form is attached.

## IV. RECOMMENDED MOTION

I move that the Highline School Board approve the award of the contract for installation, Security Video Replacement, Phase 2, which allows the Superintendent, upon receipt of all submittal requirements, to sign the construction contract with <a href="https://xxxxxx.microK12">XXXXXXX</a> in the amount of \$1,646,305.8 \$XXXXXXX, plus Washington State sales tax of \$XXXXXXX, for a total of \$XXXXXXXX.
