- Welcome and introductions by Mrs. Henderson at 4:00
- Motion to start by Staci Welch second by Emily Bridges
- Committee Chairs Update:
 - ELA – Staci Welch no updates currently.
 - Math – Brandi Panzarino waiting on the STAR window to close to look at averages for STAR Math.
 - Science – Kelly Tomberlin Students grades 3 -5 have taken two Science DSBA's and the averages from the two are 3rd grade DSBA 1- 72% DSBA 2- 63%, 4th grade DSBA 1-67% DSBA 2-79%, 5th grade DSBA 1- 64% DSBA 2- 66%. These are very rigorous, and teachers and students are working on making positive progress to increase proficiency.
 - Technology – Heather Hatfield Teachers and students are logging into different servers for laptop/tablet wifi and it has been a positive outcome. Teachers are interested in the SIPPS App.
 - Parent Involvement – Amber Allen At this time we are still holding off on parents and volunteers in the building but will re visit this later in the year. Parents responses to Title 1 virtual nights have been great!
- School Improvement Funds – Ms. Crawford said we have additional School Improvement Funds that can be used to provide supplemental Math or Science help. Kelly Tomberlin suggested a subscription to Generation Genius. Amber Allen made a motion to purchase a subscription to Generation Genius with these funds, Kelly Tomberlin seconded the motion.
- Discussed PFEP – No parent input, additions, or changes at this time.

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- **Midyear Reflection – The data we have is from October due to the testing window being extended. Grades 3-5 STAR data shows that for ELA our goal is 70% proficient and we are showing 67%. Our plan is to continue kagan strategies, additional resource teacher hired and work with teachers on understanding and utilizing i ready data. Our math goal is 70% proficient and we are showing 47%. In addition to pulling data after the window closes, we plan to incorporate small group math interventions during 90-minute math block and use high yield math routines daily. Also, the district is doing a math blast afterschool program in March. Our science goal is 60% proficient and we are showing 66%. Yay, keep working on those DSBA's. Students with disabilities goal is 48% and we are showing 32%. Our plan is to continue providing those students with additional help.**
