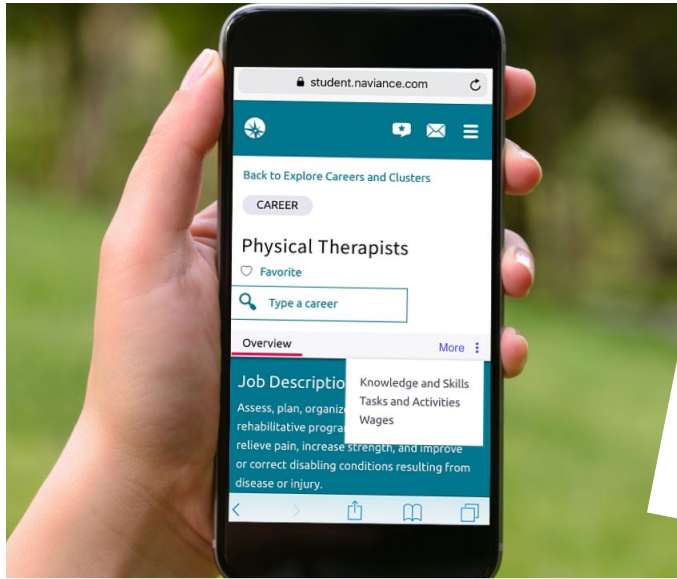

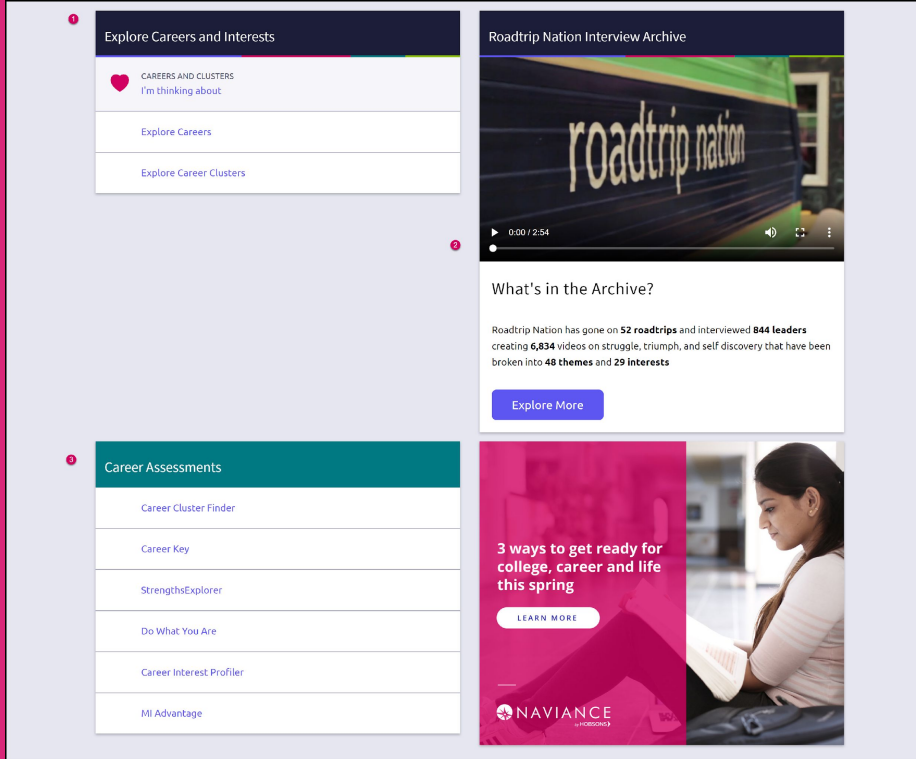

**Conventional**  
Conventional occupations frequently involve following set procedures and routines. These occupations can involve working with data and details more than with ideas. Usually, they require a good command of numbers and the ability to work with data.

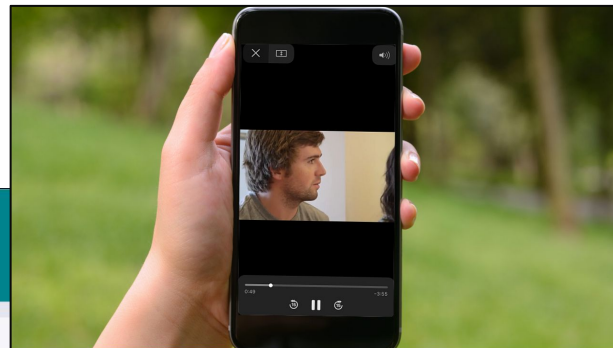
