AUTOMOTIVE - Boys & girls will be introduced to automotive tools and fasteners, make and model identification, engine disassembly, tire rotations, and On-Car fluid maintenance inspection.

BABYSITTING – Boys & girls will have the opportunity to learn about strategies related to First Aid, CPR, and basic safety protocol related to babysitting.

COMMERCIAL ARTS -- Boys & girls will create a variety of visual arts projects. Materials used range from fuse beads to paper mache to various art media.

COSMETOLOGY -- Boys & girls will have lots of fun while learning different techniques of hairstyling, manicuring, and face and hand massage.

CULINARY ARTS (Also includes Baking & Pastry Making) –A basic cooking experience for the budding young chef! Boys and girls will be introduced to different ways of building flavors in a variety of savory soups, meals, and entrees which will be brought home every night. (Only register once for culinary arts. If you accidentally register twice; we will adjust your registration accordingly. We will use our waitlist to adjust as needed.)

DIGITAL PHOTOGRAPHY -- Boys & girls will get hands-on experience with some of the latest digital cameras and professional techniques, taking photos and learning how to download, save and print their pictures.

INTRODUCTION TO GREEN ENERGY TECHNOLOGIES AND ENGINEERING: Campers will get hands-on experience designing and constructing a prototype of a windmill (wind turbine). Each camper will bring home a wind turbine that they personally designed, constructed and redesigned using the Engineering Design Pro.

METALS -- Boys & girls will learn to safely bend and form steel along with welding the steel together while creating a fun take-home project.

Career Technical Programs- Advanced

ADVANCED WOODWORKING: This runs for One Week during the AFTERNOON ONLY. Boys & girls will apply their basic carpentry skills and learn new advanced skills while creating a great take-home project. *There is a \$40 fee pertaining to the additional material cost. (Going into 7th & 8th grade)

ADVANCED COSMETOLOGY: This runs for One Week during the AFTERNOON ONLY (Session 1 week 2 and Session 2 week 2). Completion of the morning cosmetology career option is a mandatory prerequisite. Boys & girls will apply their basic cosmetology skills in addition to learning new advanced techniques of hairstyling, manicuring, and face and hand massage.

ADVANCED VIDEO: AFTERNOON ONLY. Boys & girls will explore their creative side through acting & creating small skits, singing their favorite songs on stage, or trying their hand at comedy.

ADVANCED CULINARY: This runs for One Week during the AFTERNOON ONLY. Boys & girls will apply their basic culinary skills and learn new advanced master chef skills to create meals and entrees, as well as, prepare and serve lunch to two family members or friends of their choice. *There is a \$40 fee pertaining to the additional material cost. (Going into 6th, 7th, and 8th grade)

ADVANCED AUTO: This runs for One Week during the AFTERNOON ONLY. Boys & girls will apply their basic mechanical skills in addition to learning new advanced skills related to more complex automotive tools, brake installation, tire rotation, and fluid checks, among many more exciting skills. (Going into 6th, 7th, and 8th grade)

STUDIO ART: This runs for one week during the AFTERNOON ONLY. Boys & Girls will apply their basic arts and crafts skills while concentrating on painting tips and techniques for beginners. You will draw, collage, and make sculptures using the Elements and Principles of Art and Design.
