Unlucky 13- Marian Coach Eyes Cure For Fumbling

Coach Lee Albrecht is seeking a serum for a virus called fumblitis as he prepares his Marian High gridders for Saturday's contest with Angel Guardian of Chicago.

A varsity contest is billed for 2 p.m. at Bloom field.

Marian will try for its second victory in three starts, while trying to wipe out last Saturday's 32-0 defeat by Luther South.

The backs were guilty of 13 fumbles in that contest and 10 of these were recovered by Luther South.

While Marian's line carried out its assignments well on both offense and defense, the play of the forwards couldn't overcome multiple fumbles.

The line opened holes for the backs and stopped Luther's attack. The winners failed to mount a single sustained drive, capitalizing on recovered fumbles.

Tom Galloy, second string end, earned promotion to the first unit off his play against Luther. Albrecht also praised the work of guard Jim Addyman.
