

Baptisms are held on the 1st Sunday of the month in english. Please call the parish office at least 2 months in advance. Sponsor letters are necessary for Godparents and must be confirmed and practicing Catholics in good standing with all their sacraments of initiation. Class for parents and godparents before baptism are obligatory.

New Year's greetings from our Pastor

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ, Happy New Year!

I hope you had a blessed Christmas time and that you are enjoying some quiet time together with family and friends.

As we begin a new year, we thank the Lord for all the blessings he has bestowed upon us during 2022. I would like to take this opportunity to highlight some of the many expressions of your generosity, mercy, and kindness.

This year Blessed Trinity delivered 520 casseroles to Camillus House, which helped to feed 5200 people! We likewise delivered over 4800 PB&J Sandwiches to feed the homeless in Downtown Miami. As it is our tradition, every year we help Misión Santa Ana by providing gift cards for school supplies, Thanksgiving, and Christmas for a total of \$5,756. Our Outreach Act of Love Drive collected 281 socks, 187 T-shirts, 172 undergarments and 1 blanket. We received \$600 in cash donations which allowed the Outreach Ministry to duplicate the above items for them throughout the year.

The Knights of Columbus donated \$200.00 which allowed the organizer of Choose Love to buy several pants at the thrift store. They also allocated \$2000 to help support four seminarians in their studies. They support the Respect Life Ministry and many other initiatives in our parish and school. As a parish we are called upon to serve and aid people in our parish boundaries who are going through a difficult time. Thanks to your generosity every week with the poor box and through our chapter of St. Vincent de Paul in Blessed Trinity we provided \$17,216 in financial help to cover expenses such as food and utilities.

One of the many blessings we have at Blessed Trinity is to have a parochial school. This year through the generosity of some parishioners, the Teresian Scholarship, and the Archdiocese of Miami Tuition Assistance Funds we were able to help some of our school families. These families attend Mass every Sunday and actively participate in the life of the parish were able to receive assistance for a portion of their tuition costs for a total of \$21,089.

Our Blessed Trinity School provided 14 Thanksgiving baskets for families in need in our community. BTS also coordinated a toy drive and donated food items to the Leadership Learning Center at St. John Bosco. We were able to fill the back of a pickup truck with toys and food!

Thanks to your generosity with the Baby Bottle Campaign, our BT Respect Life Ministry was able to provide close to \$6,000 to help our pregnancy centers in the Archdiocese of Miami.

These are just a few of the many good works that happen here at Blessed Trinity Parish and School thanks to your commitment to serve Christ in others. It is only through your generosity and the parishioners who have served in these various capacities that Blessed Trinity is able to make these charity drives possible. On behalf of all those who have and will continue to benefit from your kindness and generosity, I thank you and am grateful for each one of you.

As we celebrate Mary Mother of God and we continue to rejoice in the Incarnation of the Son of God during this Christmas Season, I pray that we may continue to fulfill our mission to Bring Christ to All and All to Christ, especially those who are most in need of his love and mercy.

May God continue to bless you and your family. Be assured of my prayers.

Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo, ¡Feliz Año Nuevo!

Espero que hayan tenido una Navidad bendecida y que estén disfrutando de un momento tranquilo junto a sus familias y amigos.

Al comenzar un nuevo año, agradecemos al Señor por todas las bendiciones que nos ha otorgado durante 2022. Quisiera aprovechar esta oportunidad para resaltar algunas de las muchas expresiones de su generosidad, misericordia y bondad.

¡Este año Blessed Trinity entregó 520 cazuelas a Camillus House, que ayudaron a alimentar a 5200 personas! También entregamos más de 4800 sándwiches PB&J para alimentar a las personas sin hogar en el centro de Miami. Como es nuestra tradición, cada año ayudamos a la Misión de Santa Ana entregando tarjetas de regalo para útiles escolares, Acción de Gracias y Navidad por un total de \$5,756. Nuestra Campaña de Acto de Amor de el grupo de Outreach

recolectó 281 calcetines, 187 camisetas, 172 ropa interior y 1 cobija. Recibimos \$600 en efectivo.

Donaciones que permitieron al Ministerio de Outreach duplicar la ayuda para ellos durante todo el año.

Los Caballeros de Colón donaron \$200.00 que permitieron al organizador de Choose Love comprar varios pantalones en la tienda de segunda mano. También asignaron \$2,000 para ayudar a apoyar a cuatro seminaristas en sus estudios. Los KofC apoyan el Ministerio Respeto a la Vida y muchas otras iniciativas en nuestra parroquia y escuela.

Como parroquia, estamos llamados a servir y ayudar a las personas en los límites de nuestra parroquia que están pasando por un momento difícil. Gracias a su generosidad cada semana con la alcancía para los pobres y a través de nuestro capítulo de St. Vincent de Paul en Blessed Trinity proporcionamos \$17,216 en ayuda financiera para cubrir gastos tales como alimentos y servicios públicos.

Una de las muchas bendiciones que tenemos en Blessed Trinity es tener una escuela parroquial. Este año gracias a la generosidad de algunos feligreses, la Beca Teresiana y la Arquidiócesis de Miami Tuition Assistance Funds pudimos ayudar a algunas de nuestras familias escolares. Estas familias que asisten a misa todos los domingos y participan activamente en la vida de la parroquia pudieron recibir asistencia para una parte de sus costos de matrícula por un total de \$21,089.

Nuestra escuela Blessed Trinity proporcionó 14 canastas de Acción de Gracias para familias necesitadas en nuestra comunidad. BTS también coordinó una colecta de juguetes y donó alimentos al Centro de Aprendizaje de Liderazgo en St. John Bosco. ¡Pudimos llenar la parte trasera de una camioneta con juguetes y comida!

Gracias a su generosidad con la Campaña del Biberón, nuestro Ministerio de Respeto a la Vida pudo proporcionar cerca de \$6,000 para ayudar a nuestros centros de embarazo en la Arquidiócesis de Miami. Estas son solo algunas de las muchas buenas obras que suceden aquí en la Parroquia y Escuela de Blessed Trinity gracias a su compromiso de servir a Cristo en los demás. Es solo a través de su generosidad y de los feligreses que han servido en estas diversas capacidades que Blessed Trinity puede hacer posible estas campañas de caridad. En nombre de todos aquellos que se han beneficiado y seguirán beneficiándose de su amabilidad y generosidad, les doy las gracias y estoy agradecido por cada uno de ustedes.

Couples interested in having their picture taken with Archbishop Wenski should arrive by 4:00pm with Mass starting at 5:30pm.


