There are no changing or storage areas at the Arena, so please come fully dressed and do not bring any items with you. Toyota Arena requires that all graduates and parents be searched by Arena security prior to entering. Graduates should not bring any items that may cause a distraction during the ceremony. No unauthorized items may be worn over the gown. Toyota Arena will not allow balloons, horns, wrapped gifts, and other items at their discretion into the Arena. Wrapped gifts will have the wrapping removed prior to entering the Arena or the item must remain in your vehicle.
