Declaration of Intent and Oath of Candidacy

This form must be filed by all candidates. The form must be filed with the District clerk not less than 40 days prior to the election (**March 23, 2023**). Please return the completed oath to me no later than 12:00 noon on Thursday, March 23, 2023, so that I can get them to the County Election Administrator by 5:00 p.m. that day. The oath must either be notarized or be signed in front of the District Clerk who acts as the District's Election Administrator.

Form C-1-A Statement of Candidate:

All candidates must file a Form C-1-A with the Commissioner of Political Practices in order to have your name placed on the ballot. File a C-1A form with the COPP's office by filing electronically in the user-friendly CERS system

The Statement of Candidate must be filed in CERS.

If you do not intend on raising or expending money as part of your campaign, list yourself as the treasurer, and the name and address of your personal bank for the campaign depository information.

- Candidates for these offices must designate themselves either a 'B' box candidate (less than \$500 will be cumulatively raised and spent), or a 'C' box candidate (more than \$500 raised/spent).

- 'C' box candidates are required to file C-5 campaign finance reports.

Form C-3 Code of Fair Campaign Practices:

This is an optional form you may file with the Commissioner of Political Practice Candidates may file a C-3 in CERS at any time, but it is a voluntary form and is not required
