Notification of Suspicious Activity

Dear Parents and Guardians,

Out of an abundance of caution, I am writing to make you aware of a situation being investigated by the State Police that involves an individual approaching females in the area and asking sexually explicit questions. In some instances, the individual exposed himself to the people he approached. Similar reports have been received from multiple locations in our area and the New Holland Police as well as East Earl Police are also cooperating in the investigation. I have attached the press release from the State Police, which includes additional information as well as how to contact them if you have any information to share.

Please continue to be vigilant and share this information with your children as you deem appropriate. Our district staff and bus drivers are also aware and will be on the lookout for anything suspicious or concerning as well. ## **INDECENT EXPOSURE/SUSPICIOUS PERSON INCIDENTS**

**Narvon Road, Salisbury Township, Lancaster County-** On January 11, 2023, at approximately 1713 hours, Troopers with PSP Lancaster responded to the 900 block Narvon Road, Salisbury Township, Lancaster County for a report of a suspicious vehicle. At 0814 hours, a royal blue sedan approached two juvenile females at a school bus stop and the driver of the vehicle asked the juvenile's sexually explicit questions. A short time later, the suspect vehicle fled northbound on Narvon Road, turning right onto Red Hill Road. The girls described the driver as a white non-Hispanic male, approximately 40 years old, with brown hair, a gray mustache, crooked teeth, thin build. The vehicle was described as a royal blue, 4-door sedan.

Further investigation revealed that several other females in the area encountered a similarly described vehicle and individual asking similar sexually explicit questions but during these incidents the driver exposed himself to the females.

PSP Lancaster has received reports of similar incidents also occurring in Elizabeth Township, Brecknock Township, Terre Hill Borough, Caernarvon Township, and Salisbury Township. New Holland Borough Police Department and East Earl Township also have ongoing investigations.
