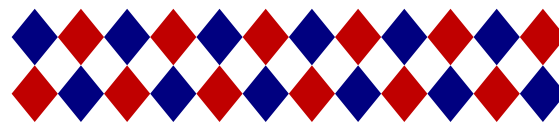


Purpose of Skills USA

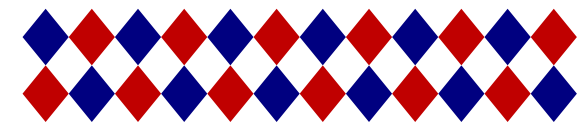
Nondiscrimination Policy

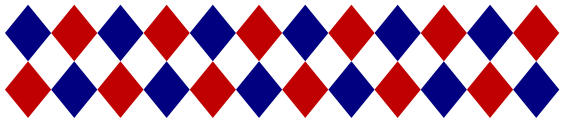

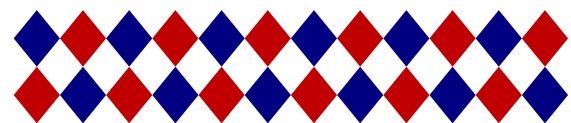


Cosmetology/ Barbering Program

Preparation of the student will include the following techniques.

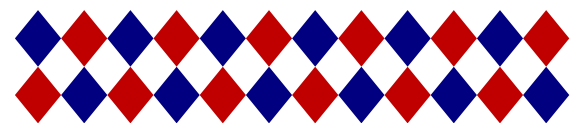
- Hands on experience with the use of mannequins and live models.
