Dear AC Families,

The staff at Amanda-Clearcreek Elementary is excited to begin another year. With no turnover in the teacher staff, there will be many familiar faces and teachers are excited to meet you and your child in the coming days. We recommend bus riders ride the bus to school on the first day of school. This will assist with the child knowing what bus to ride home. For students who do not ride the bus, student drop off is located in the front of the building, where the flag pole is located. Students will enter the building at 8:25 when the bell rings. The tardy bell will ring at 8:35. Please keep in mind that for the safety of all of our students, parents can not escort their child to the classroom. We will have staff members at the doors and throughout the building to help escort students to their classrooms.

To accommodate families with multiple siblings in different areas of the district, Elementary Open House is Friday, August 12. 3rd Grade families will meet with Mr. B in the cafetorium at 5pm. 4th and 5th grade families will meet in the cafetorium at 5:45pm. Please park in the rear of the building and enter by the doors by the playground or park in the high school parking lot and enter the West entrance. After meetings students will be able to go to classrooms, drop off supplies and meet their teachers. We will then have popsicles on the playground!

STUDENT DROP OFF

If you are dropping off your child, the earliest time for drop off is 8:20 at the front entrance, only.

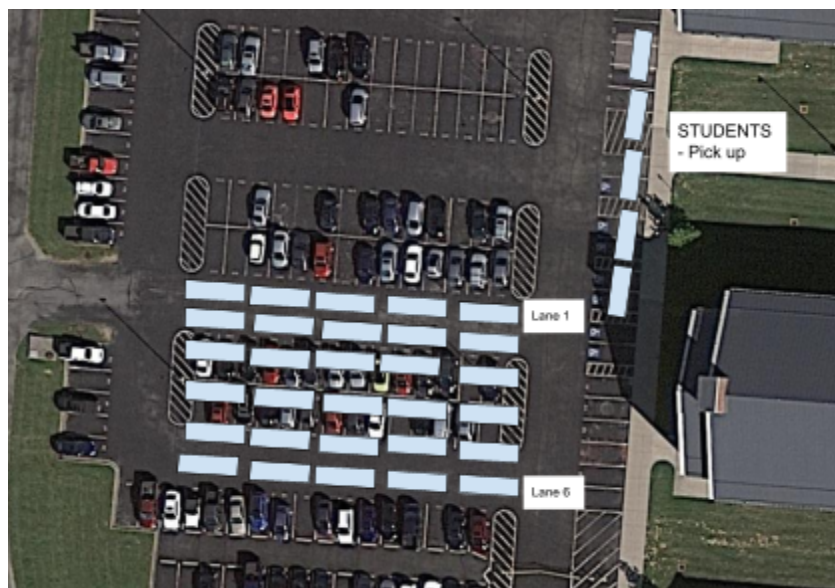
Parents may line up outside in the driveway, but students will not begin unloading until the teacher comes out at 8:20.

STUDENT DAY

Our school day begins at 8:25 a.m. and ends at 3:05 p.m. Students will be counted tardy if he/she arrives at class after 8:35 a.m. Late arrival students must be signed in by the adult dropping them off.

STUDENT DISMISSAL

Bus riders will be dismissed out of the building (flag pole) at 3:05 p.m. Car riders and walkers will walk to the west entrance and head to the parking lot at 3:05 p.m. Parents will enter the high school parking lot.. After the first 5 cars pull up to the curb and park. The next car (6th car) will begin lane 1. Cars will park 5 deep. No car should be below the light posts. This blocks access to the other parking lanes. The 11th car will start lane 2. Arrangements have been made with high school so cars should not be blocking our lanes. As always please be patient. Walkers will be dismissed as soon as we get to the curb, walkers are intended for those students who live in the village limits. Parents should not be parking along Oak Street (football field) to pick up their students as "walkers".





ABSENCES

Just like your employer, we need to be notified if your child will be absent or late to school. Please call our attendance line at (740) 969-7253 before 9 a.m. The automated system will begin making attendance calls for absent students at that time. It's important to set the tone now, that coming to school on time, and every day is important for your child's growth and development. Together, we are developing work habits that will transpire into adulthood. Contact the school social worker, secretary, or myself if you have trouble getting your child to school.
