Does my child need to be toilet trained to attend preschool?

Children should be mostly self-sufficient in the bathroom, know when they need to use the bathroom and have few accidents.

What will my scholar learn in preschool?

Social and Emotional Development

- Interact with other children and familiar adults
- Follow classroom routines and rules with guidance
- Show some self-direction
- Begin to name feelings of self and others
- Start to perform self-care tasks independently

Physical Development

- Move body with some balance and control
- Use strength and control with blocks, puzzles, playdough and crayons

Language and Literacy

- Respond to stories read aloud
- Name some letters in their name

Mathematical and Scientific Thinking

- Begin to count
- Sort objects by color, shape or size
- Use their senses to observe and investigate their environment

Art & Creativity

- Create their own art

What will my scholar learn in prekindergarten?

Social and Emotional Development

- Talk and play with other children and adults
- Solve problems: asks adults for help if needed
- Express feelings, needs, opinions and wants.
- Show self-regulation

Art & Creativity

- Use different materials to create art

Physical Development

- Move body with coordination
- Use small motor control with various materials

Language & Literacy

- Tell a familiar story
- Follow directions that have two parts
- Start to notice beginning and ending sounds in words

Mathematical and Scientific Thinking

- Copy a design that repeats
- Sort objects in more than one way
- Use words to describe quantities, shapes and sizes
- Think of what might happen next
- Count and plays with numbers

Proof of Birth

[Required]

Provide proof of your child's birth. A copy of birth certificate, I-94 or passport are acceptable.

2

Immunization Record

[Required]

Provide a copy of your child's immunization record. Parents may file a medical exemption signed by a health care provider or provide notarized, signed conscientious objection form.

3

Proof of Income

[Required for all tuition income levels except Level G.]

Provide proof of household annual adjusted gross income for all levels of tuition except Level G. Two current paycheck stubs, taxes or W-2 forms are acceptable. Scholarship applications may require different proof of income.

4

Health Forms

[Required if applicable]

If your child has a health need that requires medication or special attention when your child is at school, parents/guardians are required to complete health form(s). If your child has a current asthma, seizure or severe allergy action plan, your clinic can send a copy of the plan directly to the program nurse by fax: 763-391-8762. If you are in need of health forms, forms are available on the district website www.district279.org/services/health-services or can be requested from the program nurse.

STEP THREE

Lottery Payment
Class Confirmation

Lottery

Space in our program is limited. Participants are selected through a random lottery on February 24, 2023.

All required registration documents must be turned in no later than noon on February 23, 2023 to be included in the lottery on February 24, 2023.

Payment

A non-refundable \$25 registration fee and first month tuition payment is collected at time of registration.

Payment transactions will not occur until after the lottery is held. Charges will appear as *Osseo Area Schools*.

Cash, Check, Discover, MasterCard, VISA, Amex or electronic bank payments are accepted. Make checks payable to ISD 279.

Class Confirmation

After the lottery date (Feb. 24) allow five to seven business days to receive class confirmation and payment receipt by email. If all of your class choices have filled parents/guardians will be contacted by phone.

Registrations received after February 24, 2023: class placements will be communicated from the program office by email.

Calendar

Classes in our program follow a schedule from Sept. 5, 2023 to June 7, 2024.

Cancellation Policy

The \$25 registration fee is non-refundable. Tuition refunds will be prorated based on your scholar's last day of class.

If a class is canceled by the program due to low enrollment the \$25 registration fee and first month of tuition will be refunded in full.

Continuous Registration

After the lottery date registration will continue year round until all classes are full.

Discounts

- 5% discount for tuition paid in full for the school year.
- 15% tuition discount for a sibling(s) enrolled in our Preschool or PreK program during the same school year.

Limited Scholarships*

We offer a limited number of scholarships through the State of Minnesota. Families that are eligible for a scholarship will complete the scholarship application, pay the \$25 registration fee plus the first month's tuition, based on income.

If your child is awarded a scholarship, the registration fee and tuition will be refunded to you. If your child is not awarded a scholarship, you would continue to pay the monthly tuition. We will keep your application on file and if a scholarship becomes available, we will contact you.

Photo/ Image Agreement

A parent/guardian or scholars' photo/image may be used by the program in print, computer or electronic media, video or audio recording and film. If a parent/guardian wishes to deny this, follow the school Board Policy and Procedure 515 found on Osseo Area Schools website www.district279.org.

Pre-Registration

Scholars currently registered for the 2022-2023 school year have an opportunity to pre-register for the 2023-2024 school year.

Tuition

Monthly tuition is on a sliding fee scale based on adjusted gross household income and family size.

Tuition is divided into nine equal monthly payments from September to May. Tuition is due on the 15th of each month. Invoices are emailed monthly to account owners. A \$10 late fee will be charged if a payment is not received by the 20th of the month. Tuition will be prorated based on the date your child starts in a class.

TUITION

Select family size and adjusted gross household income to find the monthly tuition for a class. Proof of income is required at time of registration except for Level G. *If the income guidelines and tuition rate would prevent you from registering your child call 763-391-8777 to discuss financial assistance.*
