Rockcastle County, KY

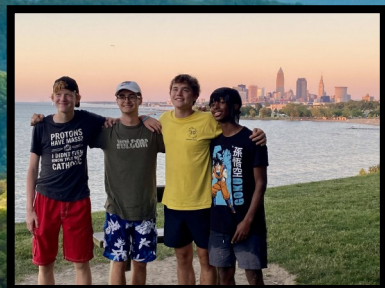
The service activities will focus mainly on housing repair and construction and students will learn more about the challenges of rural poverty.
