

ESD 105 Regional High School Art Show Guidelines

2023 – VIRTUAL ART SHOW

Exhibit Entry Requirements

Art work for the ESD105 High School Art Show will be judged based on three criteria:

Creativity Artwork demonstrates original thinking and expressive, artistic expressions

Composition Artwork demonstrates a unique and sensitive way of answering artistic problems. It illustrates student understanding of and ability to interpret the elements of art and the principles of design. It makes a unique statement.

Technique Artwork demonstrates student competency in using the medium to achieve the desired outcome.

Impact The Artwork makes a statement, shows inspiration, solicits emotions and meaning.

Guidelines

The following guidelines will insure the fair and impartial judging for the ESD105 High School Art Show.

- **Regular Education Entries:** Teachers are encouraged to submit up to **15 entries** all inclusive. Each teacher is asked to judge all of their student art using the OSPI judging guidelines (listed above) as a base line for choosing the best student work to enter in the show.
- **Photography Entries:** Photography teachers are encouraged to enter photo entries. Photography is judged by a separate team.
- **All entries must have a title.**
- All artwork must be matted. Frames are optional. Art must be **ready to hang** with strong, secure wire, etc. The ESD105 High School Art show will be hung for three weeks and we ask the teachers to make sure the art will hang safely. Art must hang on brackets that measure ¼ in. wide. If the entry does not have wire, the hanger opening must allow for at least ½ inch wide.
- All entries must be accompanied by the ESD105 Student Registration Form completed, signed by the student and authorized by a parent or guardian.
- Student Registration Forms: Each teacher is to attach a signed and dated copy of the Student Entry form to the Original Artwork. Teachers will also attach the signed ESD105 release form, as well as, the signed and dated OSPI release form. All work submitted must be completely original. If artwork is determined to be a copy, it will be disqualified from the show.
- DO NOT submit any artwork copied, replicated, or manipulated from published photographs, magazines or book illustrations or other artwork, including the internet. Original forms for reference and stimulus for your artwork may be used.
- If there is any doubt as to the originality of a piece of art work, the teacher should not submit it. The integrity of the teacher and student in submitting only original artwork is expected and appreciated.

Content Appropriateness

Appropriate artwork should be in compliance with individual school districts board policies and ESD105 policies. ESD105 reserves the right to decline artwork displaying guns, knives, gang related symbolism or context and/or other content found to be inappropriate. ESD105 reserves the right to decline artwork that is found physically in poor condition to hang.
