*\*by all learners, we mean English learners, learners with disabilities, honors learners, learners living in poverty, and any other subgroups served at ACLC*

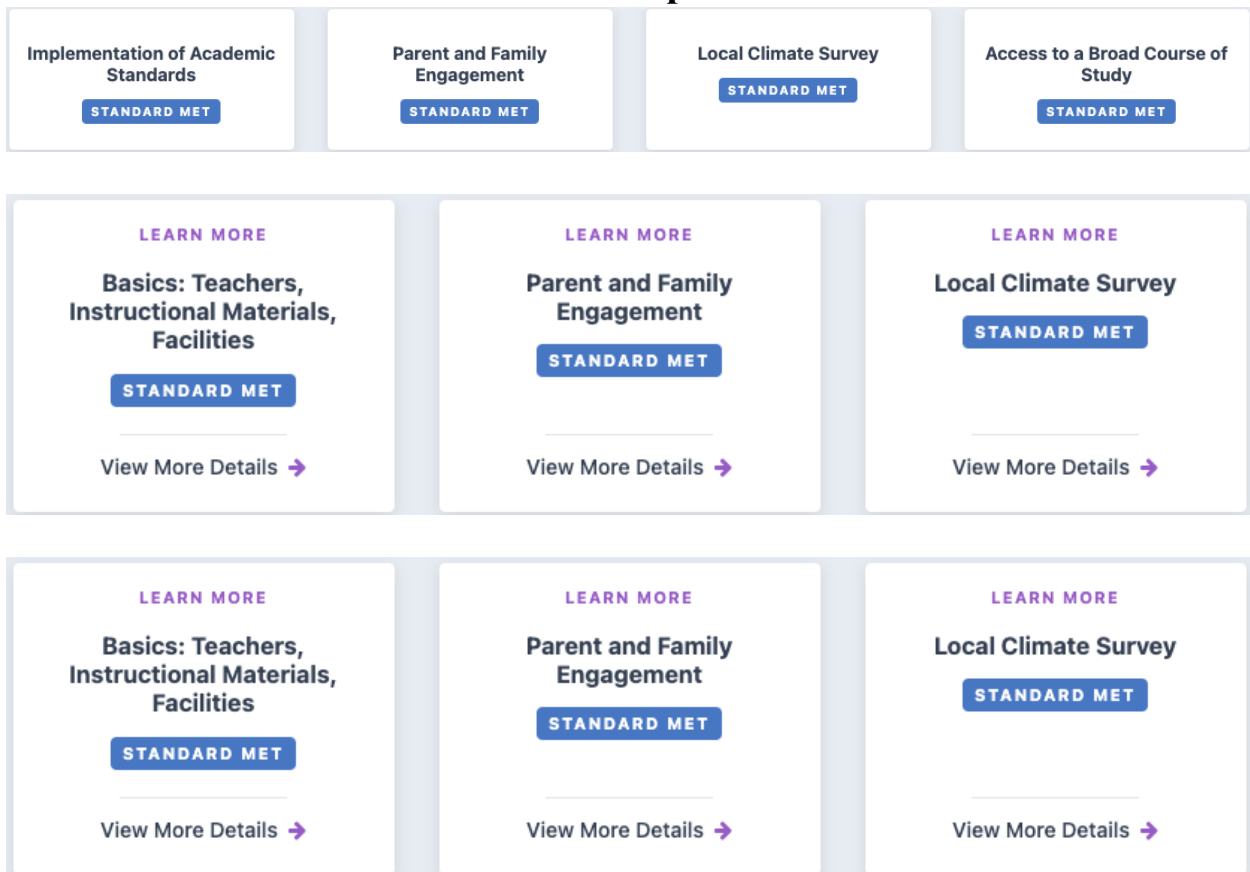

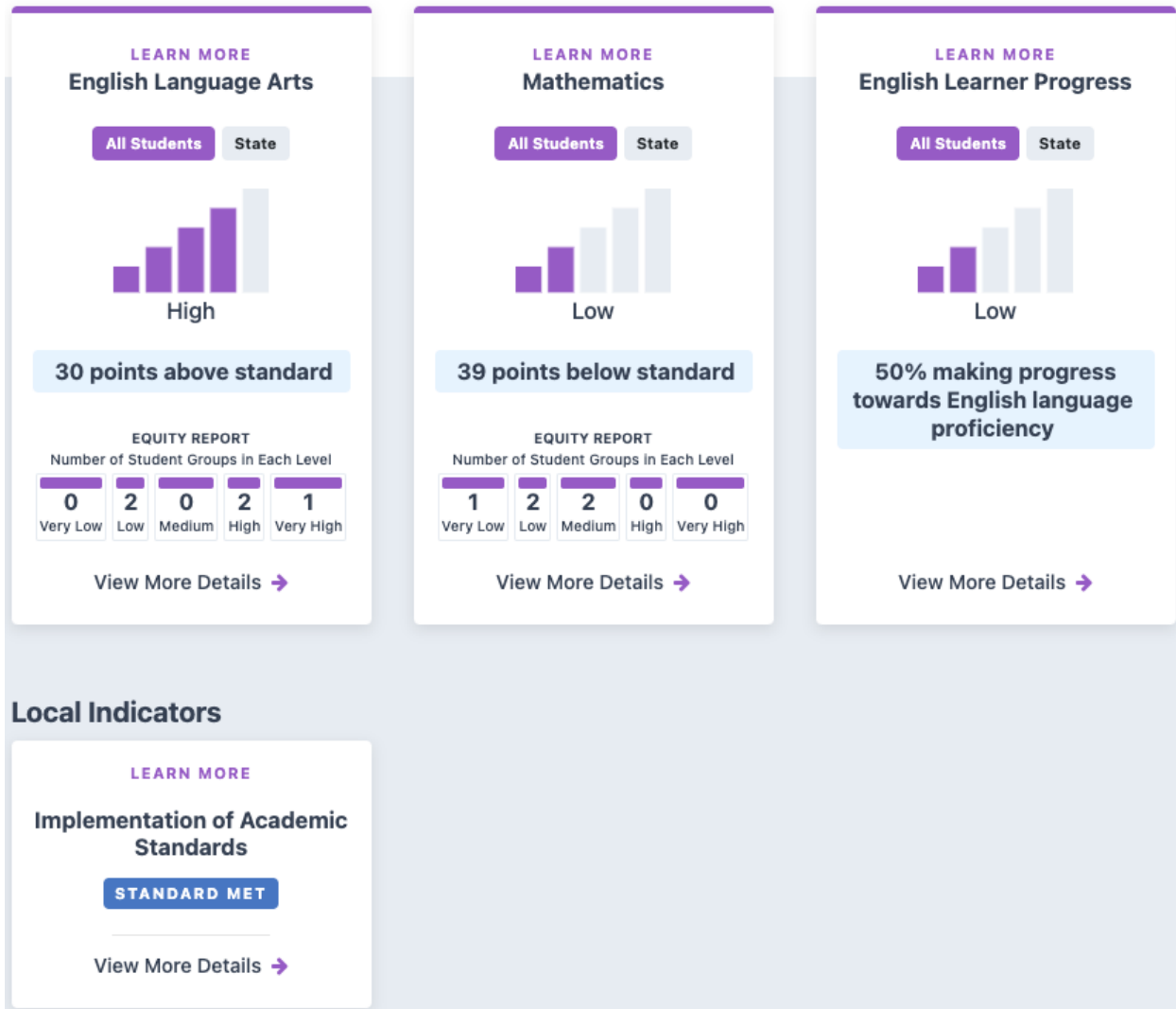

#### 4. CA Schools Dashboard Release 2021-2022

Recently, the state updated the [CA School Dashboard website](#), which shows key data-points for all CA schools with the data from last school year (2021-22). In short, the news is mixed. We got a score of “Standard Met” across the board for key indicators, which is positive; across the state and nation, scores fell in all areas of performance for almost all subgroups. Unfortunately, we mirrored that in our math scores. The good news is that we outperformed the CA state average (by 42.2 points in ELA and 12.7 points in math), and our ELA scores were high above standard. We mirror the state when it comes to our English Learners making progress towards proficiency, and 10.9% of our learners were chronically absent last year, compared to 30% at the state level.
