

2016 Capital Bond Feasibility and Development Committee Charter

Authorization

Superintendent Ron Thiele

Purpose

To advise the Superintendent as he prepares a recommendation to the School Board in regards to a potential bond measure for a 2016 ballot proposition.

Time Frame

- April 2015- June 2015: Capital Bond Feasibility & Development Committee meets on Wednesday evenings.
- June-August 2015: Superintendent presents recommendation to the School Board, which will devise its own process to present and test the recommendation in the wider community before adoption.

Goals

Recommend for Superintendent Thiele's approval the feasibility of a 2016 bond, including the proposed content, total cost, and tax impact of a Capital Bond Measure for District facility and infrastructure needs.

Parameters

Recognizing the continued and projected enrollment growth of the Issaquah School District, the proposed Capital Bond will include funding essential to:

- Ensure the Issaquah School District has all the resources possible to meet its mission and Ends student learning goals;
- Additional/expanded facilities, property acquisition of new school sites and modernization of existing district buildings
- Safely and efficiently maintain facilities and property according to State and District use standards and schedules.

Director of Educational Technology, Exec. Director of Communications, Exec. Dir. of High Schools and Director of Capital Projects will provide facilitation, secretarial support, and guidance with all technical information and data.
