A Message from the President:


Excellence in Action

Amtrak Crash Reflection

The evening of Sunday, June 26 had all the normal stressors any day does when you are beginning to travel home after a trip. We were waiting for our train, which was over two hours late, anticipating a 24 hour ride home from Raton, NM to Chicago, IL. Once it arrived, our group consisting of seven adults and 15 youths, including my son, sat in the very last rows of the train. During the beginning of the ride home, most of the youth spent time in the observation car, located two cars ahead of where our group was sitting. We were traveling home from New Mexico as part of a boy scout group who had just finished hiking and camping for five days in the coveted Philmont Scout Ranch.

Shortly after noon the following day Monday, June 27, I was settling down to take a little nap when a large bang followed by a sudden jolt sat me right up. I looked out the window to make sense of it, but all I could see was a large cloud of dust and a truck axle bouncing across the ground, an item we later found out belonged to the dump truck the train collided with. Another bang shook the train car and that is when the train began to tilt, I knew I had to brace for impact. Everyone around me did the best they could to hold steady as the train hit the ground sideways, at around 87 miles per hour, but all of us were thrown to the side of the train that was now skidding across the ground.

Once the train came to a stop, I gave myself a quick personal assessment and concluded I had no serious injury and the person who was seated next to me, now behind me, had no serious injury either. Thankfully the two of us, uninjured, had extensive First Aid training and immediately began evaluating other passengers, some more injured than others, but none of the injuries appeared to be critical or life threatening. First responders were on the scene immediately and we began to assist them with getting severely injured passengers on backboards to be loaded into the back of ambulances. The back door of the train was jammed shut from the impact, so we needed to remove the side windows, which were now the roof of the train, to get the injured out. Many of our scouts were on top of the train assisting with getting the injured to the first responders, and that was the first time I saw my son since he went to the observation car with his friends before the accident; remember the observation car was two cars ahead of where I was. I held back tears when I saw him, but knew I had to compose myself as there was work to be done. I could hear him shouting from the now open window if anyone needed extra help, his voice told me he was ok.

Once off the train, and many hours later, I could see that all seven passenger cars of the train had tipped off the track and were laying on their sides. Some of our group had already been taken to a local high school which had been established as the relocation center, others were about to be taken there, and some of the scouts and adults were still assisting on scene. Unfortunately, seven of our group of 22 had been sent to several different hospitals with injuries.

That evening, those of us who were uninjured were brought to a local hotel, and met the most wonderful local “scout Mom”, from Columbia Troop 6 in Columbia, MO, near where the train crash happened. She told us she had heard about the crash, so she and other local scout moms gathered what they could and gifted us with \$1,000 for food, water, whatever we may need. By morning, June 28, the scout moms had brought us toiletries, phone chargers and shoes. Not only did they bring these items to the hotel, they also stayed and acted as “surrogate mothers” for our scouts. They counseled them and just talked to them to help keep their minds off the accident and missing their own families.

Surprisingly, later that same day, we found out there was a chartered flight ready to take us home. We were not completely sure who was responsible for making that happen, but we were so thankful to be headed home to family and friends. Once we landed in Green Bay, WI, there was not a dry eye as everyone stepped off the plane to meet their loved ones, who were all there waiting. I don’t think I have ever embraced my family, my wife and two other sons, for as long as I did that day. It was good to be home.

As I look back, I focus on the people that were involved rather than the actual accident. I could not be more proud of the scouts and how they reacted to the situation. They did not run away, they accepted it, kept their cool and took charge. There were so many local people who dropped everything to help the victims out, from Mendon, MO to Columbia, MO. Amtrak officials were wonderful to work with, as were all the first responders, volunteers and hospital personnel. My prayers continue to be with the families of the four people that lost their lives due to the accident. I still think the efforts from the Columbia Troop 6 parents were incredible, and I will forever be grateful.

In times of tragedy, you truly see what people are made of, and in this case I know many people are made of love.



Following Faith, the Journey to Priesthood of Fr. Eric Immel

A life deeply rooted in faith led 2001 NDA alumnus, Fr. Eric Immel, to be ordained as a Jesuit priest this past summer.

“I was raised Catholic, and my family has been a part of the St. Matthew Catholic Community in Allouez for my entire life,” said Fr. Immel. “The Church was less than a mile from my family’s home and was woven into the very fabric of my first 18 years.”

This faithful life led him to Notre Dame where he graduated in 2001.

After graduation, Immel went to Saint Louis University to get his bachelor’s degree in American Studies.

It was here that he met the Jesuits.

Ever since joining the novitiate in 2011, he has spent a lot of time in school.

“In my 11 years as a Jesuit, I’ve spent six in full-time graduate education, earning a MA in Social Philosophy at Loyola University Chicago and a MDiv from the Boston College School of Theology and Ministry,” he explained.

Immel is currently doing additional studies at Xavier University of Louisiana, the nation’s only Catholic Historically Black College/University, working towards a degree in Black Catholic Studies—a degree that is very personal to him. His interest is working with the tools and the community of the Catholic Church to work for justice and against racism.

Faith has shaped every aspect of the priest’s life.

“Faith led me to make a lot of choices about where and how I wanted to be in the world,” he said. “It was my Catholic faith coupled with the support of my parents that compelled me to apply to Saint Louis University, the Catholic school where I met the Jesuits. Faith led me to sign up for a retreat my freshman year of college that gave me one of the first, and most profound, experiences of God’s love that I’ve had. It was my Catholic faith that compelled me to seek employment



at Catholic schools when I finished my education. It was faith that compelled me to consider the priesthood and stick with eleven years of formation with the Jesuits.”

Now that he is ordained, Immel feels more himself than ever before.

Reflecting on his life, he has now realized that serving as a sacramental minister is what he has always desired.

He explained, “God’s confirmation of that desire through my ordination is a profound gift.”

“The Church faces tremendous challenges,” Immel said. “For my part, I want a Catholic Church that is huge, ever-widening and always pointing toward the intimacy and mystery of a God who loves us. I hope and pray that mine is a priesthood that makes all feel welcome, that roots Christian life in the sacraments, that points toward justice, that generates a love that can be trusted and that brings people to God.”

He added, “We truly are all in this together, and now, as a priest, I feel happy to play a part well suited for me.”



