## BOARD MEMBER AUTHORITY

The Board of Education has the authority to act only when a majority of Board members is present at a duly called regular or special meeting. An individual Board member exercises the authority and responsibility of his or her position only when the Board is in legal session. The Board of Education shall not be bound in any way by any statement or action on the part of any individual Board member, including the president, except when the Board by vote has delegated such authority to that Board member.
