

## INGRAM POND

The Outdoor Education Center at Ingram Pond is designed to provide students of the Indian River School District with science-centered learning activities that they cannot experience in the classroom. These activities may be made available to other Delaware public school systems; however, all visits by Indian River students will be arranged prior to the scheduling of other districts. Visits by other school districts may also be scheduled on inservice days when the Ingram Pond staff is not involved in required district professional development activities.

The charge for the visit will be sufficient to cover expenses incurred by Ingram Pond for instruction, personnel, and materials. Any money left over will revert to the Ingram Pond fund. Districts that wish to visit Ingram Pond must be willing to accept the curriculum as it is written; no modifications will be made. At any given visit, Ingram Pond will accept no more students than they have enough resources and instructors to safely accommodate. All students will be subject to the rules and regulations required of Indian River School District students. All teachers, those both from Indian River and other districts, are expected to accompany their students to Ingram Pond, and to participate fully in the learning activities as required by the Center's staff.
