NOTES: IR had 37-23 rebounding edge. Charles Rayne had 15 rebounds. Howard led 29-20 late in first half but managed just four field goals the remainder of the game. Shelton and Spence had 10 rebounds each. Shelton had 10 points in fourth quarter – first three baskets of quarter, once off a steal and two on long jumpers. Three-point play by Spence tied game 41-41 with 5:02 left. Shelton gave IR the lead for good at 1:14 by hitting a short jumper off his own rebound.
