### District Happenings:

- Gov. Carney has announced that for the beginning of the 2021-2022 school year, everyone kindergarten-age and older in Delaware public schools must wear face coverings indoors regardless of his or her vaccination status.
- The Indian River School District will implement a staggered opening to the 2021-2022 school year. The first day of school for students in Kindergarten, Grade 6, Grade 9 and the Howard T. Ennis School (excluding preschool) will be **Tuesday, September 7**. Students in Grades 1-5, 7-8 and 10-12 will return to school on **Wednesday, September 8**. Preschool programs will begin on **Monday, September 13**.

### Major Capital Improvement Progress:

- Construction is continuing at the new Howard T. Ennis School property on Patriots Way north of Millsboro. Structural steel is nearly complete and interior and exterior walls are being erected.
- Design work is continuing for the new Sussex Central High School building. The project is slated to go out to bid next year. The new school is tentatively scheduled to open to students in the fall of 2024.

### Carver Consent Order Update:

- Community Advisory Board meetings for 2021-2022 will be held on October 5, December 9, March 1 and June 9. All meetings will be from 4:30-6:30 p.m. at Millsboro Middle School.
- IRSD hosted its first Equity Retreat at Millsboro Middle School on June 29. Activities completed at the retreat are supporting the district in drafting an updated strategic plan taking into account all of our current data.
