Pursuant to the terms of the Transportation Specifications issued by the WESTPORT PUBLIC SCHOOLS with a Proposal due date of January 26, 2023, this Addendum will clarify or modify certain identified aspects of the Specifications. This Addendum is made a part of the contract and is enforceable under the same terms and conditions as the original Specifications.

Whenever a page number, section or appendix is referred to in the following modifications/clarifications, the page, section or appendix refers to the Transportation Specifications as issued by the WESTPORT PUBLIC SCHOOLS and as described above. In locations where paragraph numbers are identified, they may be identified utilizing the paragraph symbol (¶) and the paragraph number refers to the full paragraphs on the designated page (not carry-over paragraphs from the previous page).

The items included in this Addendum are a result of questions raised at the pre-Proposal Meeting or submitted to the District subsequent to the meeting.

Questions submitted to the District, or raised at the pre-Bid meeting:

Q1. Please provide a list of the companies who requested the specs but did not attend. Also please provide a copy of the sign-in sheet from today's meeting.

A1. Interested proposers are listed above.

Q2. The cover sheet is number '1', while the next page is numbered '3' – is page 2 missing, or is this just a page numbering problem?

A2. Please double check the RFP as there is a page 2.

Q3. Item 3.4 on page 18 refers to section 4.14, which does not exist. Please provide this missing text.

A3. Item 3.4 will be removed

Q4. Item 5.6 on page 22 asks for an additional cost for seatbelts on type I vehicles – is this for lap belts or 3-point belts?

A4. Provide cost for lap and 3 point belt as seen in the adjusted pricing sheet.

Proposer's Initials:

Q5. Item 8.7.1.2, page 30, refers to the District's right to reject/replace any driver. Please consider adding the following language as clarification: "When requesting replacement of any employee, the District will state the reason(s) in writing, and such reason(s) will not violate any state or federal employment guidelines."

A5. The district will not consider this change.

Q6. Item 8.7.2.10 on page 36 refers to the district's right to reject buses 'for any reason.' Please consider adding the following language as clarification: "When requesting a vehicle replacement, the district will state the reasons in writing, and, if appropriate, allow the contractor time to correct the issue."

A6. The district will not consider this change.

Q7. Item 8.7.4.1 refers to the gallon allotment for each type of vehicle and refers to diesel fuel for 8 to 20 passenger vehicles, or type IIs. These are no longer available as diesel – can this section be edited to allow for provision of gasoline for newer type IIs?

A7. The district would accept gasoline vehicles for both of the first two bullet points under this section. The third bullet will be for 8 passengers plus 2 wheelchair vehicles.

Q8. Item 8.7.4.2 on page 38 regarding the district's provision of fuel states that 'Actual route miles shall include travel to and from the Contractor's terminal if the terminal is located within the district boundaries.' However, item 8.7.4.6 on page 39 states 'Deadhead mileage to and from the Contractor's terminal will not be included.' Please clarify this apparent contradiction.

A8. The district is willing to pay for deadhead miles as indicated only in the instance that the terminal is in Westport.

Q9. Will the District be able to leave some of the electrification section TBD. So would the proposer be able to give information and different options for next steps where we provide cost estimates in the future when a more concrete idea of the district's electrification plans is formed.

A9. The district would like pricing and will be able to negotiate to a lower amount as more data on electrification comes through.

Q10. Could the current contract rates be provided?

Thank you for meeting with our team on February 6, 2015, to review our original response to the above referenced RFP, and to discuss the needs of the District. We are aware of the financial constraints facing the District, and have crafted a revised response that we hope will work for both Westport and DATTCO.

To that end, we submit revised pricing sheets which reflect savings to the district from our first proposal. The first set of prices complies <u>with your vehicle specifications</u>, providing 77 passenger Type I vehicles, all with transit style bodies. The alternate set of prices, which represent even more savings, reflect a fleet comprised of your current vehicles, a blend of 77 and 71 passenger Type I buses, with either transit or conventional body styles. This fleet has served the district safely and efficiently for several years, and meets your fleet age requirements. Both proposals will of course comply with the age restrictions outlined in your specifications. Our revised submission also offers an upgrade to full WIFI camera equipment to enhance data retrieval and make downloading bus digital camera data more efficient.

ARTICLE 3 UNION SECURITY

Add New: The company agrees that it will permit Union's representatives or stewards to attend all new employee orientations, to discuss for 15 consecutive minutes the benefits under this Agreement and of Union membership, so long as social distancing can be achieved, at a

ARTICLE 8 ASSIGNEMENT OF WORK/CHARTER WORK

Change to Read: Section 4. General Provisions:

Effective: Upon Ratification

Section 10- If a driver reports on a Saturday, Sunday, on a Holiday or in the evening (not in conjunction with their HTS time) and the charter is canceled, the driver shall be paid two (2) hours at charter rate.

ARTICLE 21 401 (K)

Employees will be eligible to enroll into the Company's 401 (k) plan according to Plan Guidelines. Employees are auto-enrolled and can opt out of enrolling into the 402 (k) plan. The Company will match 25% on the first 4% deferred from the employee's earnings.

Beginning January 1,2021 a 401K enhancement is available only to those who contribute a minimum of 4% into their DATTCO 401 (k) account for the year and will increase the contribution benefit for those employees contributing under \$1,400 per year. The employee must be employed by DATTCO on 12/31 to receive the additional contribution.

The new contribution plan is as follows:

- Employee annual contribution is \$350 and under:
 - o DATTCO will match dollar-for-dollar
- Employee annual contribution is \$350 to \$1,400:
 - DATTCO will contribute \$350 in total, which is greater than the current 25% of the employee's 4% contribution
- For those who contribute the 4% and more than \$1,400, the plan is unchanged.

Any additional contribution will be paid into the employee's account no later than March 1st of the following calendar year.

Any changes to the 401 (k) plan that benefits non-union employees will be available to eligible employees.

ARTICLE 22 SNOW DAYS

When the company is compensated to pay the drivers for remote days, the drivers will be paid by the company for their regular HTS hours.

ARTICLE 24

PAID HOLIDAYS

Effective: 2021/2022 Day After Thanksgiving Added All eligible employees shall receive the following paid Holidays:

> Martin Luther King Day Good Friday Memorial Day

Labor Day Thanksgiving Day Day After Thanksgiving

ARTICLE 29

PAID SICK LEAVE

Beginning January, 1,2021 eligible Drivers shall earn one hour for every forty hours worked up to a maximum of forty (40) hours per calendar year. Eligible Drivers shall be permitted to use a maximum of forty (40) hours per calendar year. At the end of each calendar year any unused sick time can be paid out or rolled over at the option of the employee. It is the Driver's responsibility to submit the applicable sick leave payout form by the last day prior to Christmas break. If the form is not submitted in a timely fashion all accrued and unused time will be rolled over into the next calendar year.

ARTICLE 30 DURATION OF AGREEMENT

Change to Read: This Agreement shall remain in full force and effective until **September 30**, **2023** Notwithstanding the above, if the company renews its contract with The Westport Board of Education, the parties will meet to negotiate an extension of this Agreement, and may meet to reopen this Agreement.

Add New Side Letter: Labor-Management Committee

The Employer and the Union agree that there shall be a Joint Labor Management Committee consisting of no more than three (3) individuals from each party. Committee members shall be designated, in writing, by each party to the other. Meetings will be held at a mutually agreeable times and places so as to apprise the other of problems, concerns, and suggestions related to the operations and work force, all with the aim of promoting better understanding between the parties. Meetings will be held once per year. A written agenda shall be established for the meeting. Such meeting shall not be construed as opening the Agreement for negotiations, nor shall any subject matter at the meetings constitute a step in the grievance procedure. Participants will be paid Non-Revenue pay.

Memorandum of Understanding Pre-K's

At bidding, when a run has a pre-k included, only the Board of Education can change or remove the Pre-K's.

Memorandum of Understanding Guarantee Workday

The Company and the Union mutually agree the 180-day guarantee set forth in Article 23 of the Collective Bargaining Agreement shall not apply during any school year in which DATTCO does

not provide home-to-school transportation for the for one hundred and eighty (180) days, due to an act of god, or events beyond the company's control.
