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# Advanced Placement (A.P.)

- Year long AVHS college-level courses
- A.P. Exam in May
- Scored holistically (1-5)
- Many colleges give placement and/or credit based on score
- Internationally recognized – College Board

# College in the Schools (CIS)

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# College in the Schools (CIS)

- Students are enrolled at the University of Minnesota, but take courses at AVHS from qualified AVHS teachers
- Earn high school and college credit
- Students have full access to UMN resources
- No cost to student
- Grades earned go on an official UMN transcript

# College in the Schools courses at AVHS

- Full year courses
  - CIS Spanish (level 5, 10 credits earned for 1003-1004)
  - CIS German (level 4, 5 credits earned for 1003)
  - CIS French (level 4, 5 credits earned for 1003)
  - CIS Human Physiology (BIOL 1015, 4 credits)
  - CIS Intro to Animal Science (4 credits)
    - Career Development class (SES)
- Trimester courses
  - CIS Writing Studio (WRIT 1201, 4 credits)
  - CIS Public Speaking (COMM 1101, 3 credits)
  - CIS Multicultural America (FSOS 1211) (2 Trimesters)

# Post Secondary Enrollment Options (PSEO)

- Courses taken at a post-secondary institution
  - 10<sup>th</sup>, 11, 12<sup>th</sup>
  - 10<sup>th</sup> grade PSEO is limited to career development classes
- Earn high school and college credit
- Tuition, fees and textbooks free
- The program is administered through the Minnesota Department of Education

# Admission Criteria

- Admission is determined by individual colleges
  - University of MN – Twin Cities:
    - Primary Considerations
      - Each application is individually reviewed
      - Successful grades in rigorous classes with a B grade or higher
      - Unweighted GPA of 3.6 or greater
      - Application Window: February 1 to May 15
    - Community Colleges – General guidelines:
      - 11<sup>th</sup> grade – 3.0 GPA or acceptable standardized scores
      - 12<sup>th</sup> grade – 2.5 GPA or acceptable standardized scores
      - The priority application deadline for fall semester is June 1 and the final deadline is July 1

# Things To Consider

- Responsibility, time management, self-starting, independent learning
- High school experience?
- Winter/Spring break
- Frequency of classes – MWF, TTH, W
- Transportation
- Transferring credits to another college is dependent upon transfer rules of that college - check with freshman admitting college.
- Final Grades: If a student receives a “C” in a 4 credit college class they receive a “C” for a full year class at AVHS

# How Do Credits Transfer?

## Semester Credits vs. AVHS Credits

1	.75
2	1.5
3	2.25
<b>4</b>	<b>3.0</b>
5	3.75
6	4.50

A four credit college class

Represents a full year class at AVHS

Example: 4 credit college English class fulfills a full year of English at AVHS – in 16 weeks

# Articulated College Credit

- Agreement between AVHS and local colleges
- Earn college credits through classes offered at AVHS
- Must complete the courses in “good standing”
- “Articulated college credit record” (ACC) presented to admitting college
- Credits vary
