



Driver's Education at Westminster Information Sheet

Cost: \$365 per student

Location: Westminster Upper School

Dates: June 12th-23rd

Required in-person meeting for student & parent: Monday June 12th, 1-2:30pm at Westminster Upper School, Room 220

This summer the Community Education Department of Shelby County Schools will be offering Driver Education classes. Classes are taught by certified teachers.

This is the “golden ticket” class for students who know how to drive because they will be testing for their license (this is NOT a class to teach your student to drive). If they pass, they will get instructions on how to go online when they turn 16 to get their license without having to go to the DMV.

Driver Education: Students must have 50 miles of varied driving experience before class starts. This class is made up of one in-class meeting, online classwork, and behind the wheel instruction. Details are below:

- June 12-25, Driver's Education Class for Westminster Students only
- First day meeting on June 12 from 1-2:30pm at Westminster Upper School for students and parents.
 - Bring electronic device to enable access to internet
 - Receive instructions for completing academic phase
 - Receive instructions for setting up the RemindApp for communication and driving schedule
- Driving must be completed during the chosen session. Groups of students will drive during three 2-hour blocks. Students will not drive in inclement weather. Students will meet the drivers for drop off/pick up at the Westminster Upper School parking lot.
- Each student will receive a grade--this will not be a letter grade but instead a “Pass” and will not affect their GPA. They will be given a 0.5 credit and Certificate of Completion.
- Upon passing the written work and driving portion, the student will receive instructions to obtain their Driver License online.
- Fee: \$365.00 - price includes a gas fee.
