Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA) Parent Resources

Signed into law December 10, 2015, the *Every Student Succeeds Act* (ESSA) is the federal legislation that governs elementary and secondary education in America. ESSA reauthorized the *Elementary and Secondary Education Act* and replaced *No Child Left Behind* (NCLB).

What is Title I?

Title I schools receive federal funding to supplement the school's existing programs.



At MAS, Title I funds support school-wide programs aimed at helping all students improve their reading skills.

Parent Rights Under Title 1

You have the right to...

- ☑ Be informed about the achievement level of your child.
- ☑ Know about opportunities for parent meetings.
- ☑ Receive communication in a language you understand.
- ☑ Know the services available for your child.
- ☑ Know about the qualifications of your child's teachers.

Title I funds must be used for:

- Providing help for students experiencing academic difficulty.**
- Hiring staff and purchasing supplemental programs, materials, and supplies.**
- Providing professional development for teachers and staff**
- Offering parent programs that help them support their children's education**
