# Davie County Schools Welcomes Two New School Resource Officers

**Mocksville, North Carolina, January 17, 2023** – Two new school resource officers (SROs) began their duties with Davie County Schools on Tuesday, January 17<sup>th</sup>.

A recent \$200,000 safety grant allowed the school system to hire two new SROs to serve elementary schools and retain two current SRO positions. School safety equipment, such as handheld radios, vape detectors and outside surveillance cameras, were also included in the grant.

The new SROs are as follows:

- Deputy Elizabeth Snow is assigned to William R. Davie and Mocksville Elementary
- Deputy Steve Loos, who previously served as a school resource officer in Davie County, is assigned to Shady Grove and Pinebrook Elementary
- Current elementary SRO, Deputy Keith Hurley, is assigned to Cooleemee and Cornatzer

“SROs play such an integral role within our schools and we are excited to add two new positions at our elementary school level,” said Jeff Wallace, Superintendent, Davie County Schools. “In addition to the safety and security these officers provide our campuses, they also work to build positive relationships with students by mentoring, advising and serving as role models. The officers are fully integrated into the school and become part of the team there, where you’ll see them helping with tutoring, reading books, etc. Welcome to the team, Deputy Snow and Loos.”

Currently, Davie County Schools has nine school resource officers serving the school system.
