




The PE Kit for students in years 7-11 is made up of the following:

<p>Training Top</p> 	<p>Compulsory – red, short sleeve training top with school logo.</p>
<p>Socks</p> 	<p>Compulsory - red KHS socks. White ankle socks for summer and gym work.</p>
<p>Shorts</p> 	<p>Plain black training shorts (with school logo from Hawkes).</p>
<p>Skort</p> 	<p>Plain black skort (with school logo from Hawkes).</p>
<p>Training Pants</p> 	<p>Plain black training pants (with school logo from Hawkes).</p>
<p>Leggings</p> 	<p>Plain black sports leggings (with school logo from Hawkes).</p>
<p>Rugby Shirt</p> 	<p>Black/red reversible rugby shirt.</p>

<p>Midlayer Top</p> 	<p>Black/red ¼ zip midlayer long sleeve top (with school logo from Hawkes).</p>
<p>Jacket</p> 	<p>Showerproof black/red jacket (with school logo from Hawkes).</p>
<p>Bobble Hat</p> 	<p>Black bobble hat (with school logo from Hawkes).</p>

In addition to the above, the following sports require:

<p>Football</p>	<p>Shin pads Football boots - screw-in safety or moulded rubber studs (<i>optional</i>)</p>
<p>Hockey</p>	<p>Shin pads Gum shield</p>
<p>Rugby</p>	<p>Shin pads Gum shield Rugby boots – screw-in safety or moulded rubber studs (<i>optional</i>)</p>

Please make sure all PE kit is clearly marked with your name or use sew in name tags.

If a student is injured, the expectation is that they still wear full KHS PE kit. This will prevent school uniform getting wet/muddy when outside. This will also enable the student to take part in the lesson in a different capacity e.g. coach/official. *Hoodies/jackets or coats will not be allowed.

If no kit or the wrong kit is worn on three occasion's students will be placed on a 'PE Kit Report'. If a student doesn't bring kit they will be expected to wear PE kit provided by the school.
