## Information sheet for Application for Maude Ella Park Scholarship

The Madison County Democrat Woman's Club is currently seeking applications for the 2021 Maude Ella Park Memorial Scholarship. This \$500 scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior, male or female, from Madison County. The winner of the Maude Ella Park Memorial Scholarship will be forwarded to the Democratic Woman's Club of Kentucky for consideration for the state scholarship award. The winner at the state level will receive a \$1,000 scholarship.

### Scholarship Requirements:

- Must be a resident of Madison County who will graduate in spring 20201.
- Must have a minimum unweighted 3.0 Grade Point Average (GPA). Submit an official transcript as proof.
- Applicant must plan to attend an accredited Kentucky Institution of Higher Learning.
- Applicant must be a registered Democrat, if not yet able to register, must submit a notarized statement that the applicant will register as a Democrat as soon as eligible.
- **Provide a list of activities you have participated in on behalf of the Democratic Party (BE SPECIFIC). These activities can be at school, in the community, campaigns, voter registration drives, transporting voters to the polls, handing out materials, and voting. This is one of the most important parts of the application.**
- Provide a list of activities pertaining to school, civic or community clubs, and other scholarships received.
- Provide a list of special recognitions or honors received.
- Submit two (2) character reference letters: one from a school official or teacher and one from a community leader. No letters from relatives may be submitted. The letters must be attached to the application and should speak to the student's academic ability, character, school and community involvement, and potential for active citizenship in the future.
- Complete and sign the Scholarship Application, acknowledging that the essay is the work of the applicant and that the applicant will be required to accept the scholarship award(s) in person.
- The winner of the Maude Ella Park Memorial Scholarship will be submitted for consideration for the Democratic Woman's Club of Kentucky \$1,000 scholarship award. The winner of the that scholarship will be required to attend the DWCK State Convention in the fall\* and give a four minute talk on: 1) Why I am a Democrat; 2) What are my future goals; 3) What the DWCK Scholarship means to me. A hotel room for one night and three tickets (for recipient and parents) will be provided by the DWCK.
- Essay will not be returned to the applicant.
